

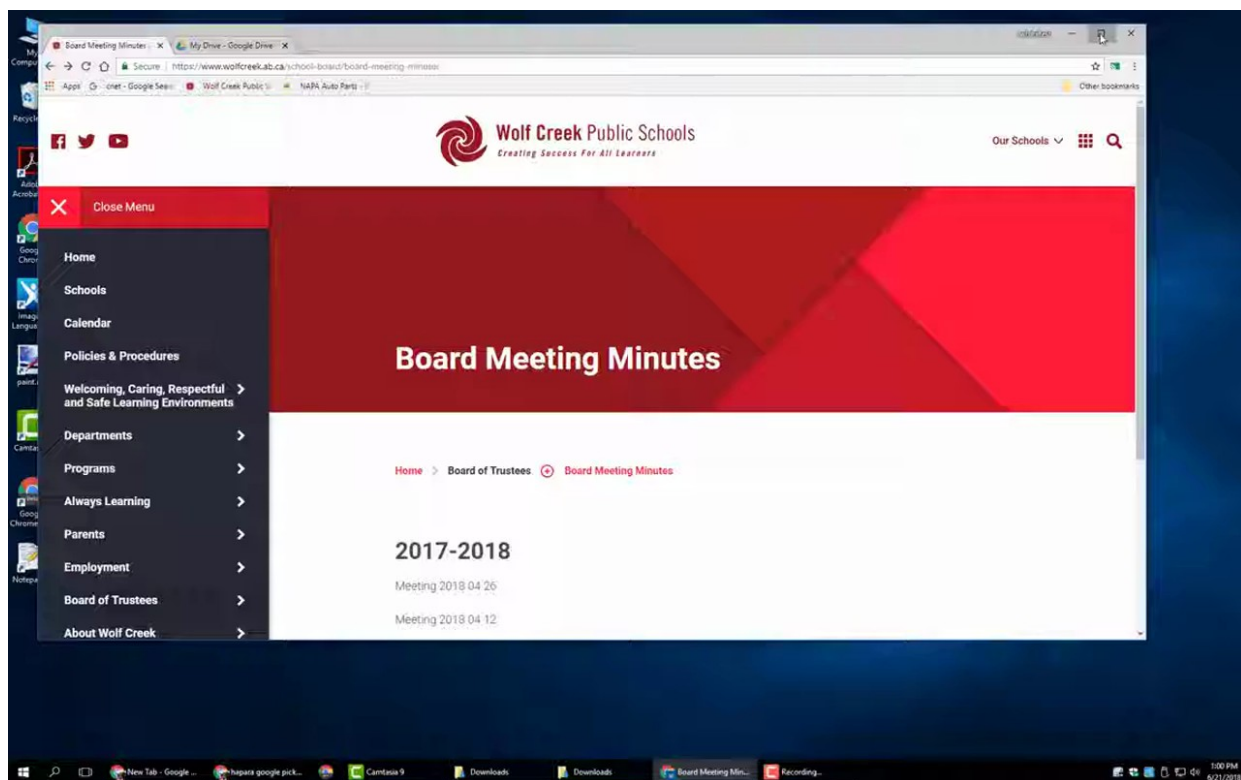
Change How Chrome Opens PDF Files

Google Chrome step-by-step guide

Before you begin: Chrome menus can move after an update. If a label looks different, use the search box at the top of Chrome Settings to find the named setting.

STEP 1 Open Chrome settings

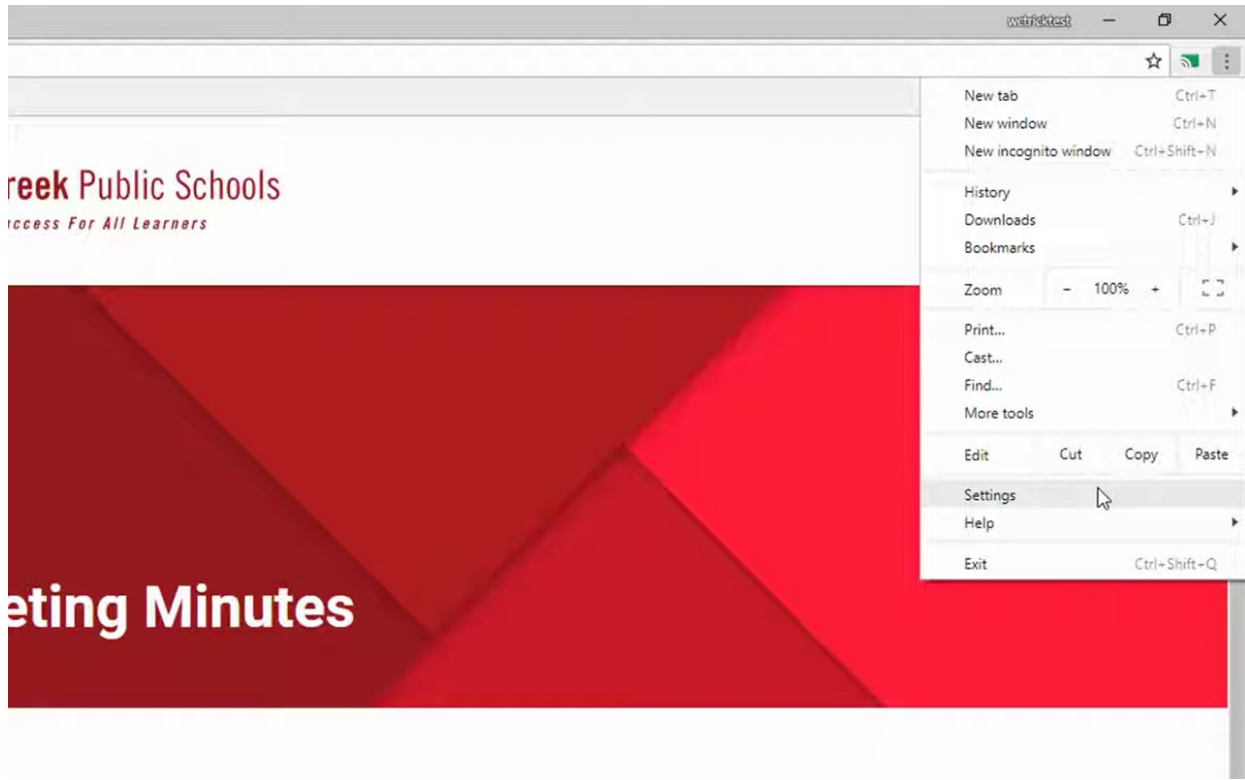
Open the three-dot Chrome menu and select Settings.

STEP 2 Open Privacy and security

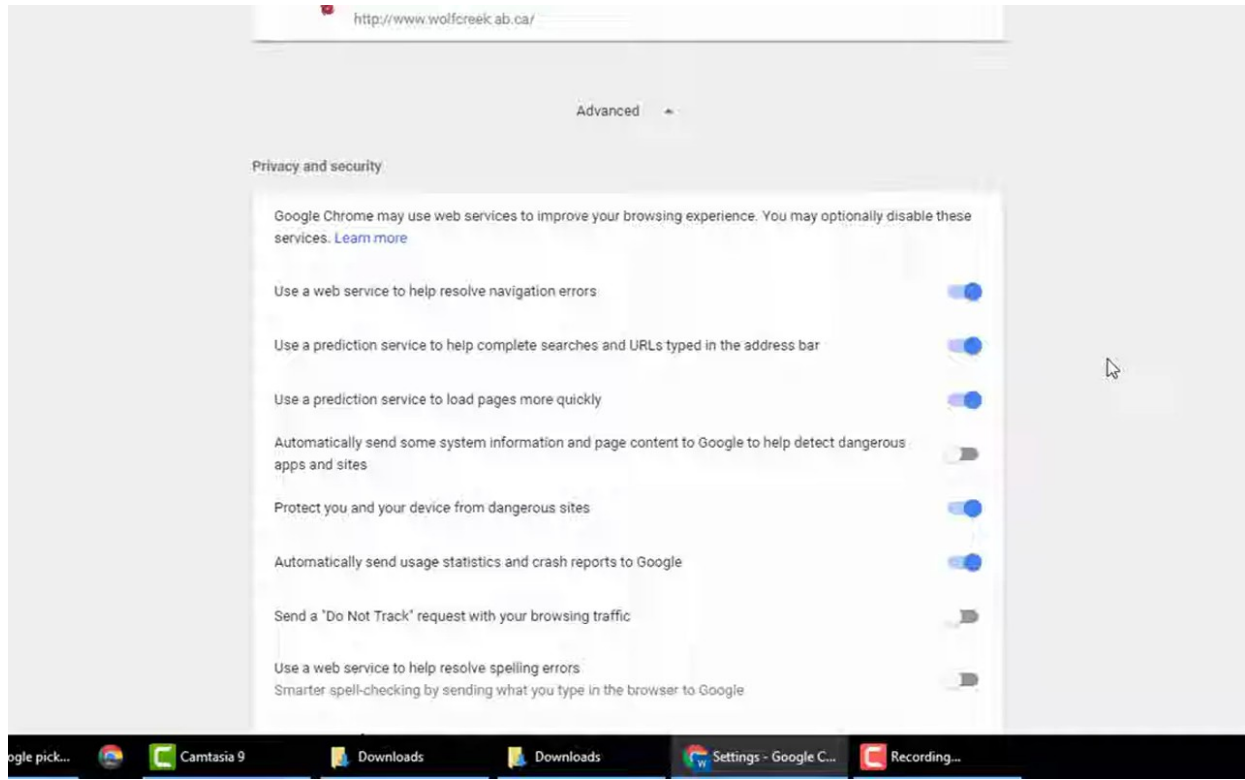
Select Privacy and security, then open Site settings.

STEP 3 Find PDF documents

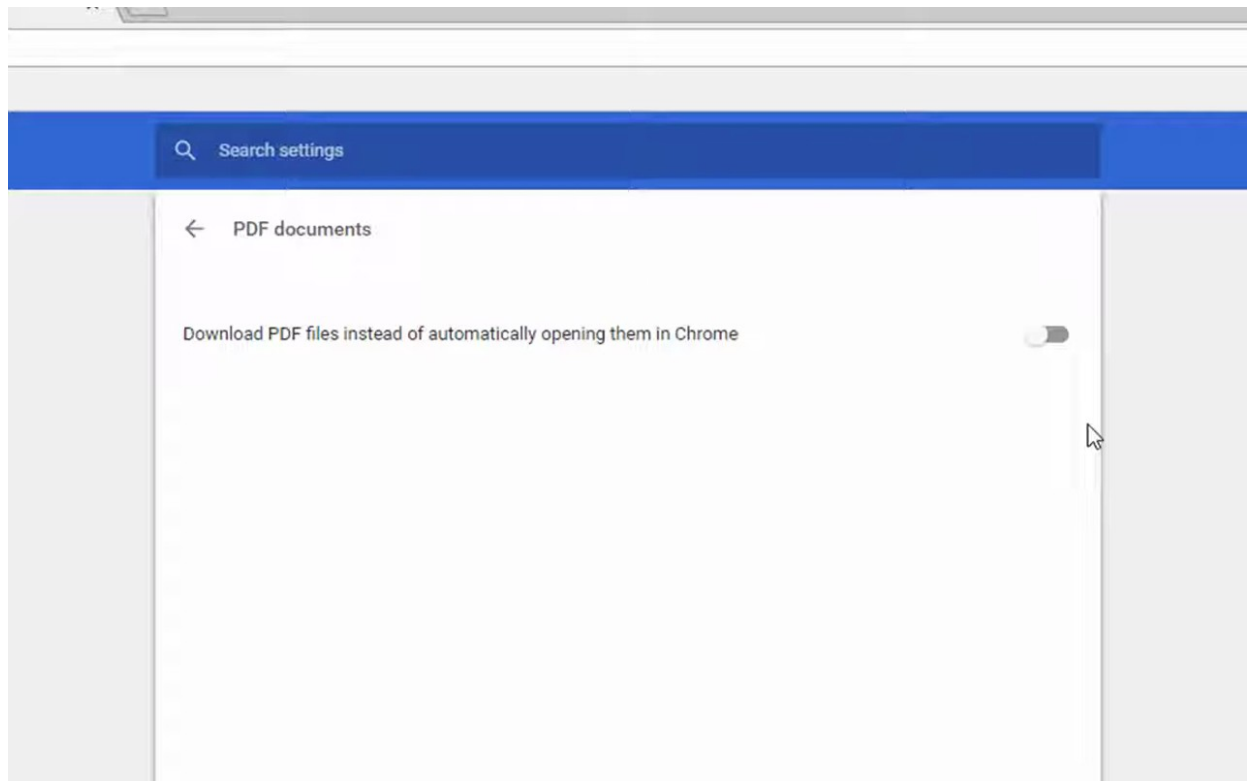
Open Additional content settings and select PDF documents.

STEP 4 Choose the PDF behaviour

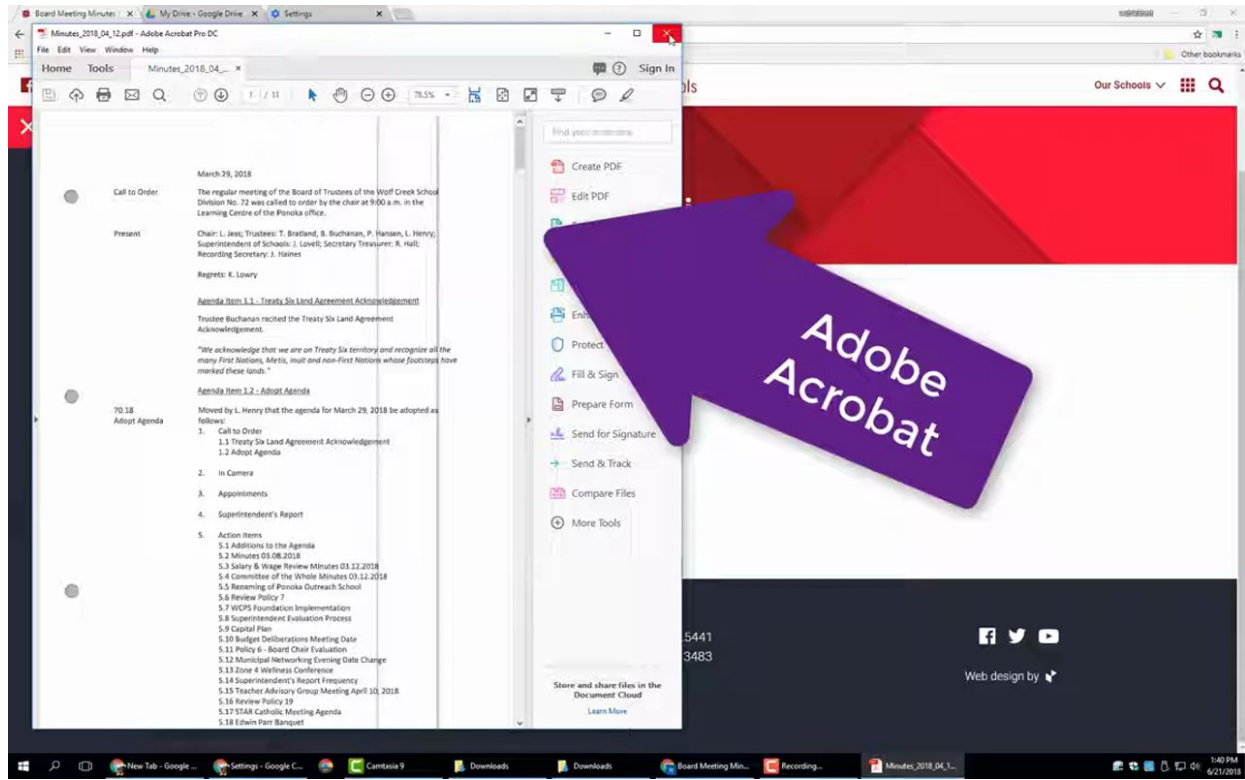
Choose whether Chrome downloads PDF files or opens them in Chrome.

STEP 5 Test a PDF link

Open a PDF link and confirm that Chrome now handles it the way you selected.
