

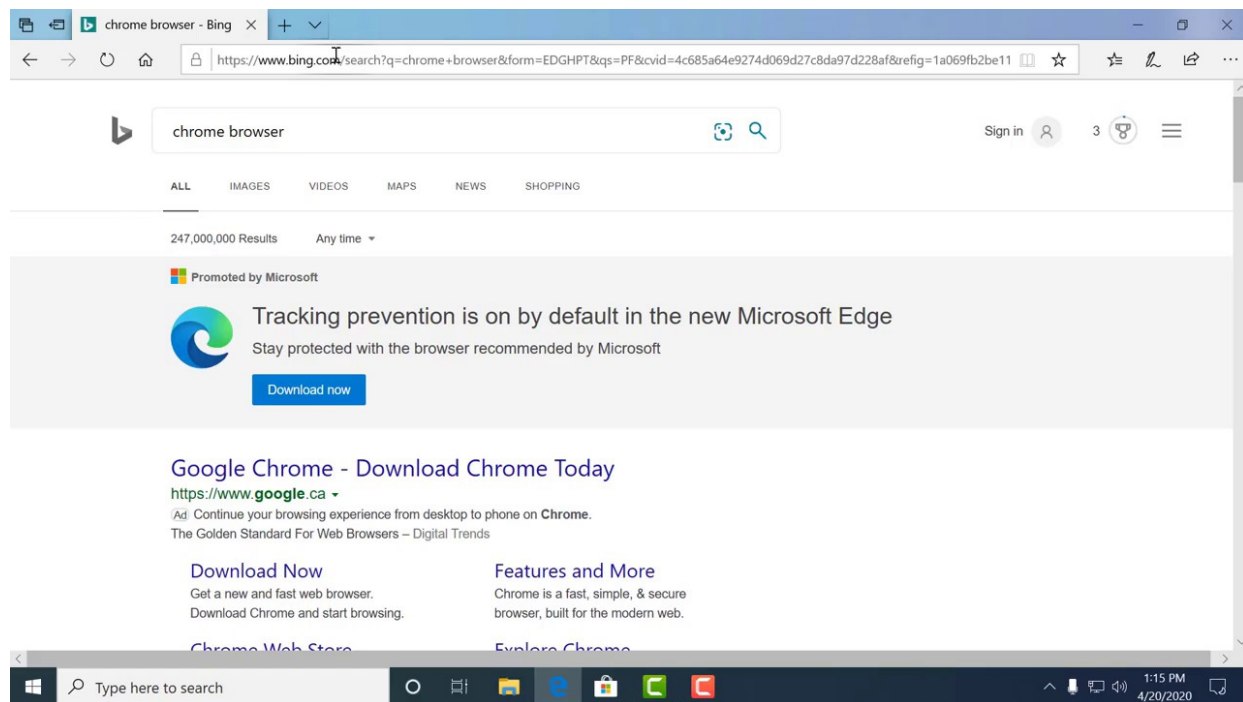
Install Google Chrome on Windows

Google Chrome step-by-step guide

Before you begin: Chrome menus can move after an update. If a label looks different, use the search box at the top of Chrome Settings to find the named setting.

STEP 1 Open the Chrome download page

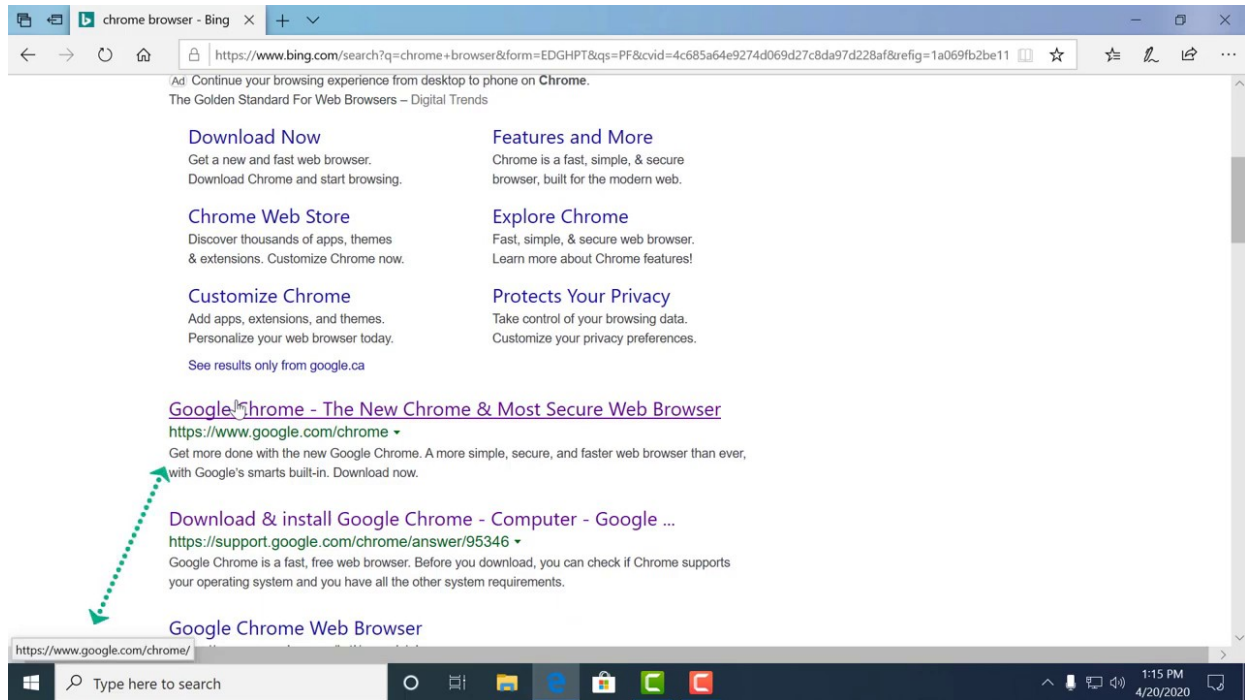
Using the browser already installed on the computer, go to the official Google Chrome download page.

STEP 2 Download Chrome

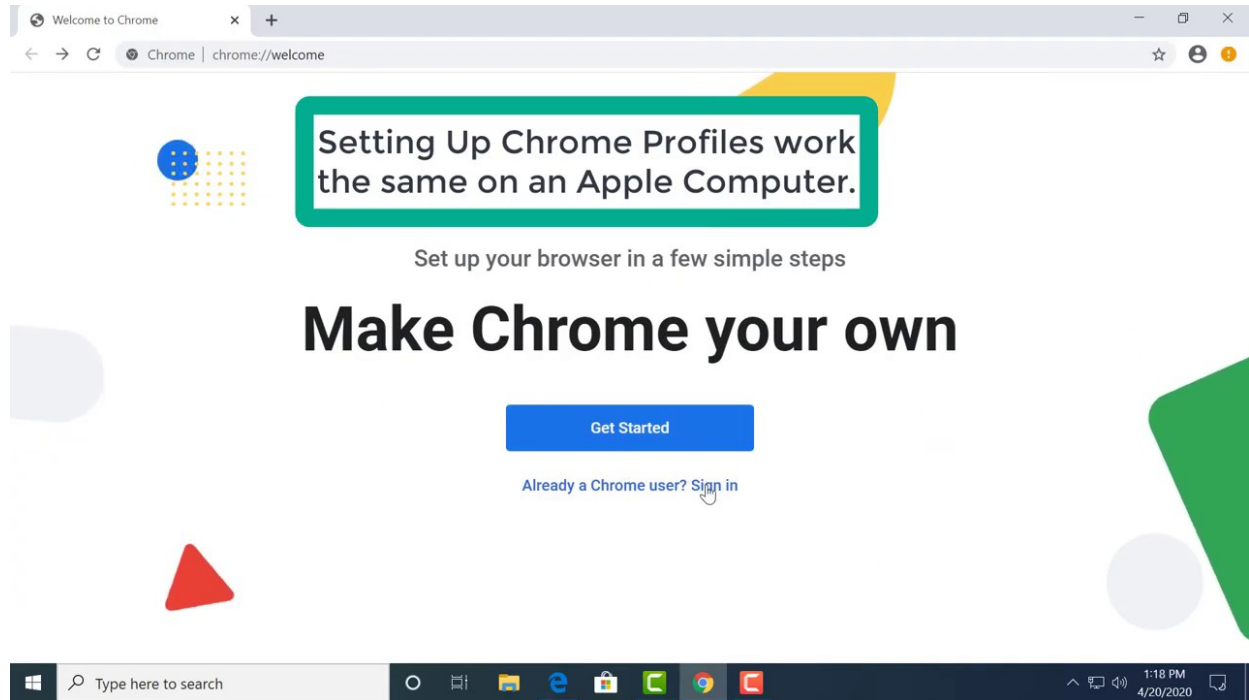
Select Download Chrome.

STEP 3 Run the installer

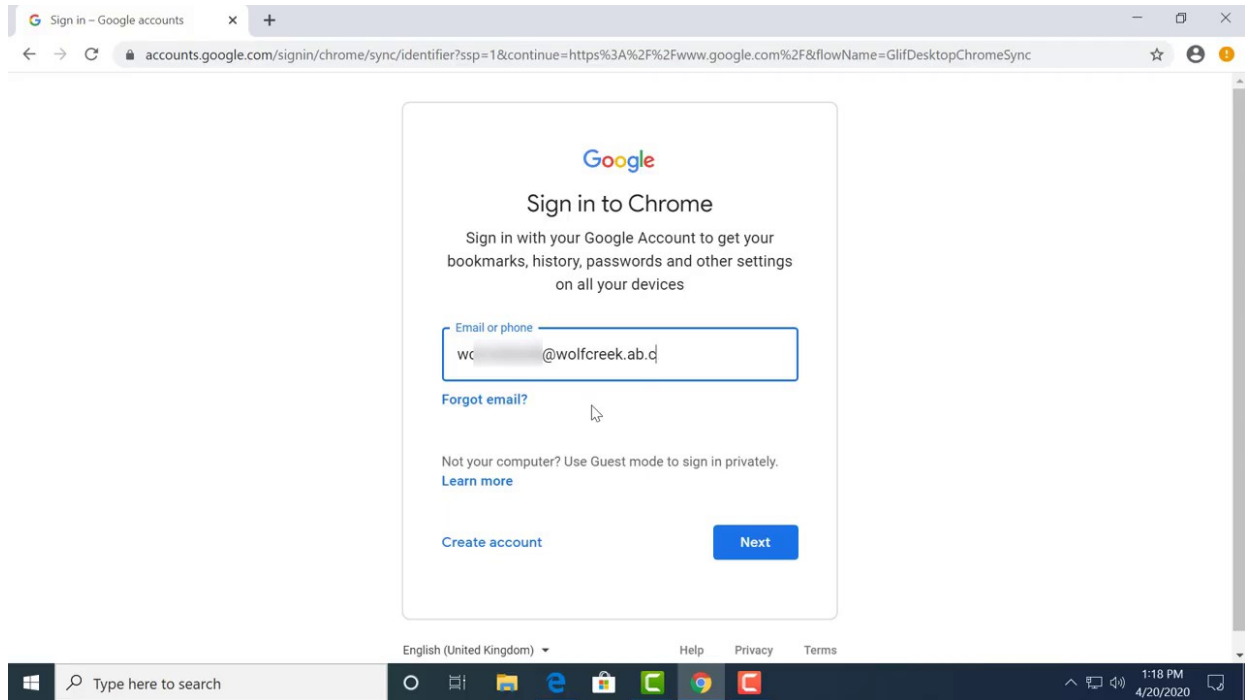
Open the downloaded Chrome installer and allow it to make changes when Windows asks.

STEP 4 Open Chrome

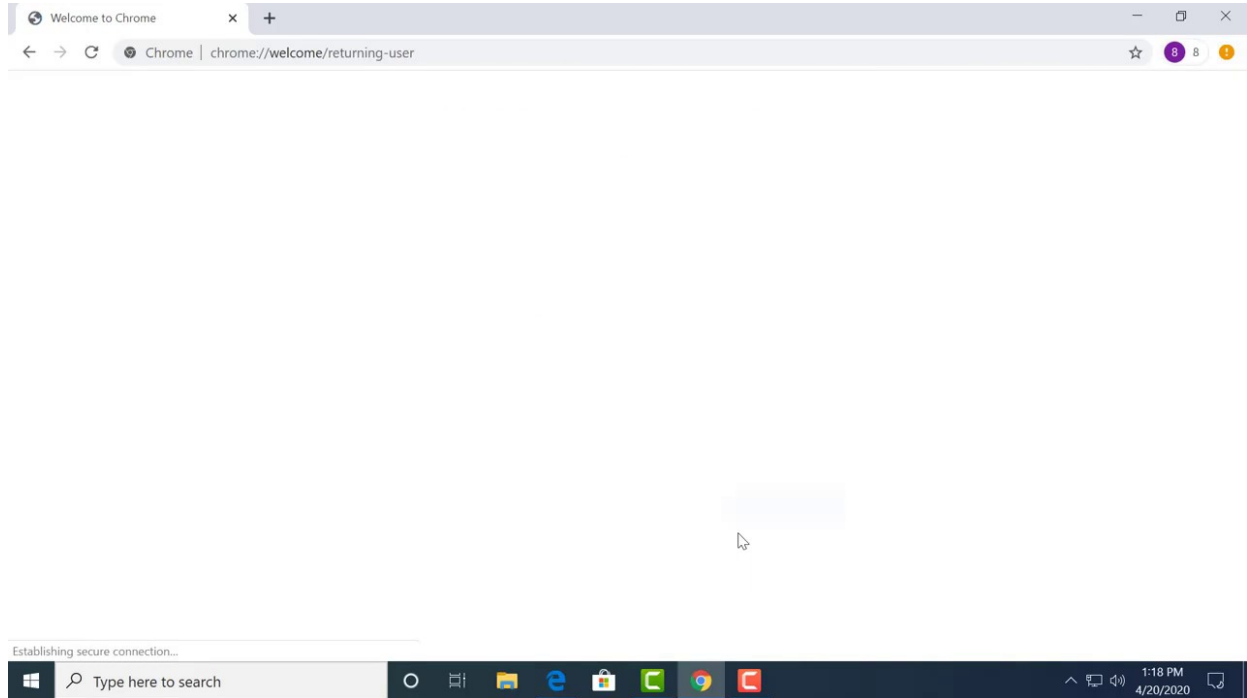
When installation finishes, Chrome opens automatically.



Open Chrome.

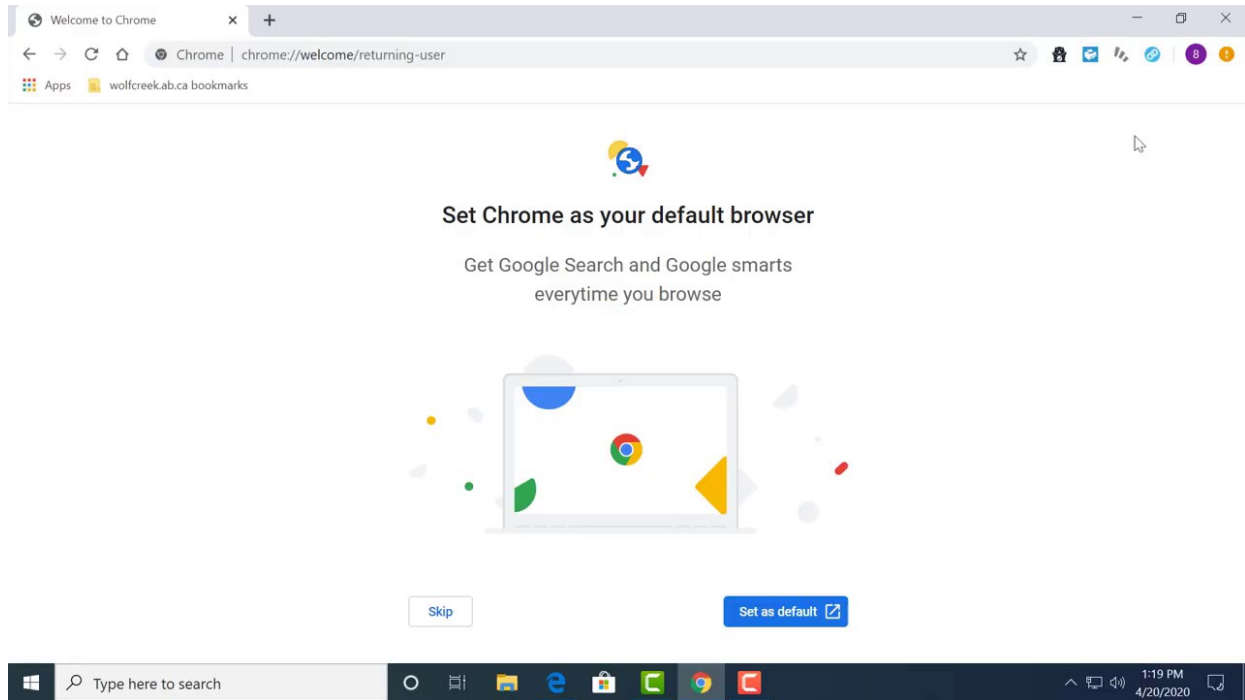
STEP 5 Start sign-in if required

If you use Chrome sync, select the sign-in option.



STEP 6 Use your Wolf Creek account

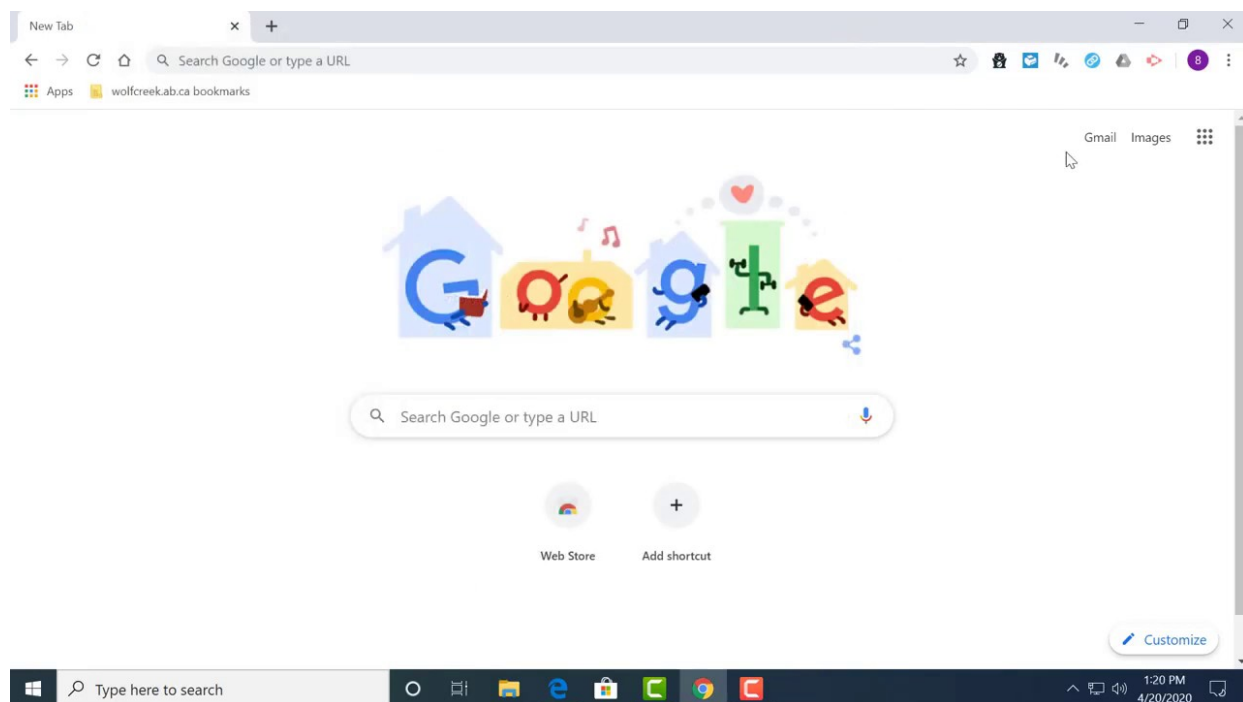
Enter your Wolf Creek Google account and complete the sign-in prompts.
