

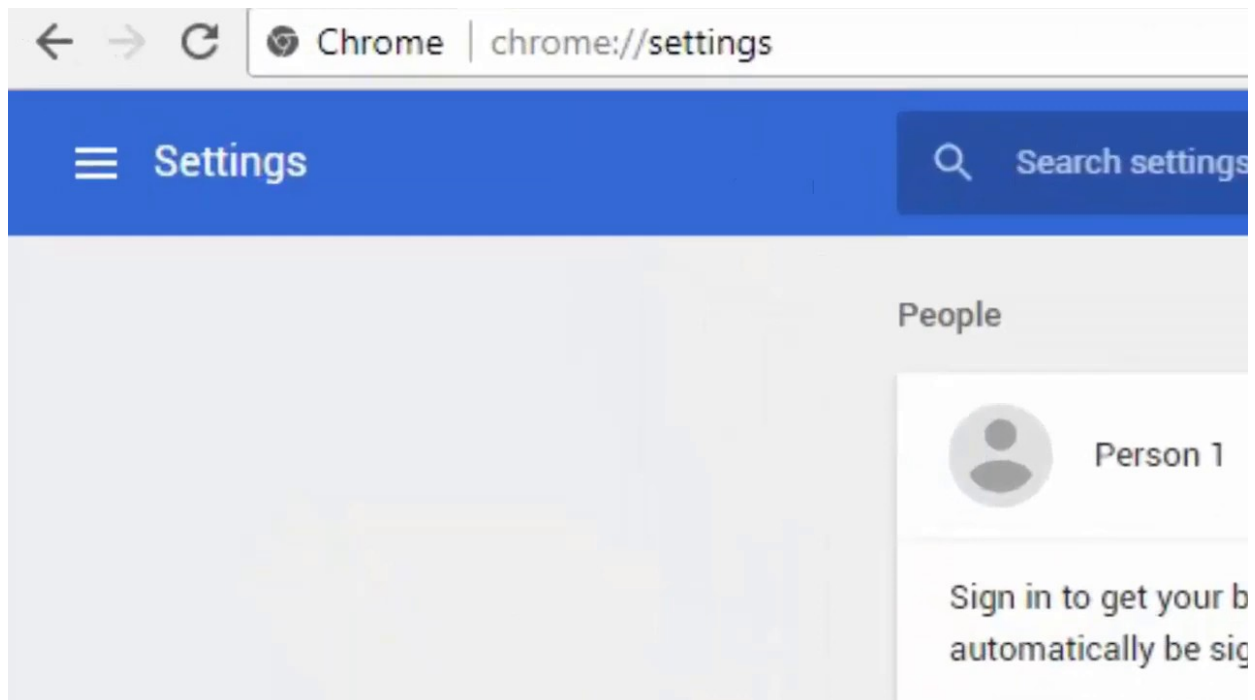
# Remove Chrome Website Notifications

Google Chrome step-by-step guide

Before you begin: Chrome menus can move after an update. If a label looks different, use the search box at the top of Chrome Settings to find the named setting.

## **STEP 1** Open Chrome settings

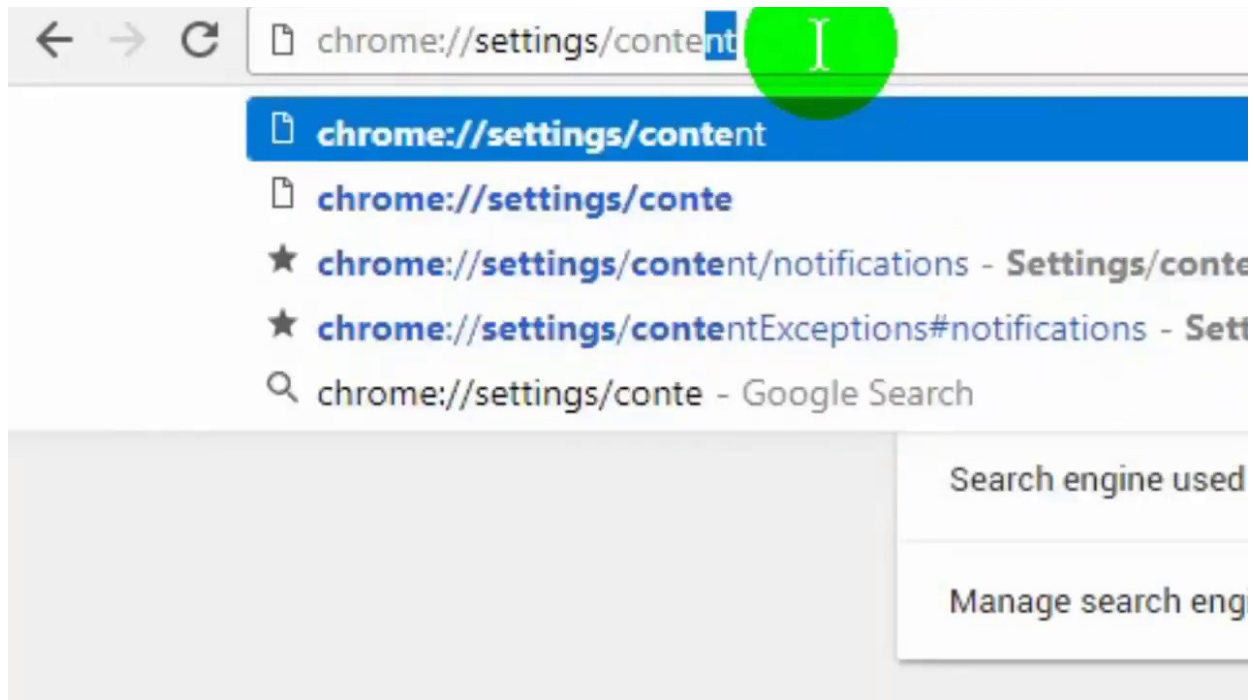
Open the three-dot Chrome menu and select Settings.

## STEP 2 Open Site settings

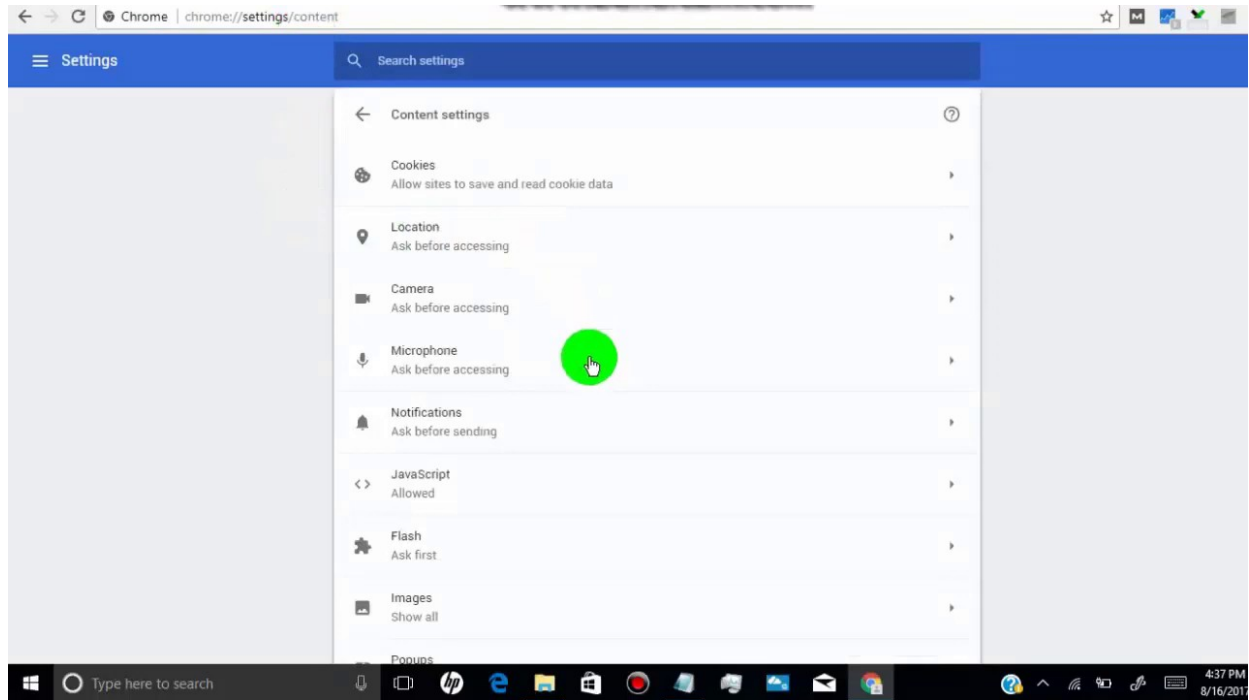
Select Privacy and security, then select Site settings.

### STEP 3 Open Notifications

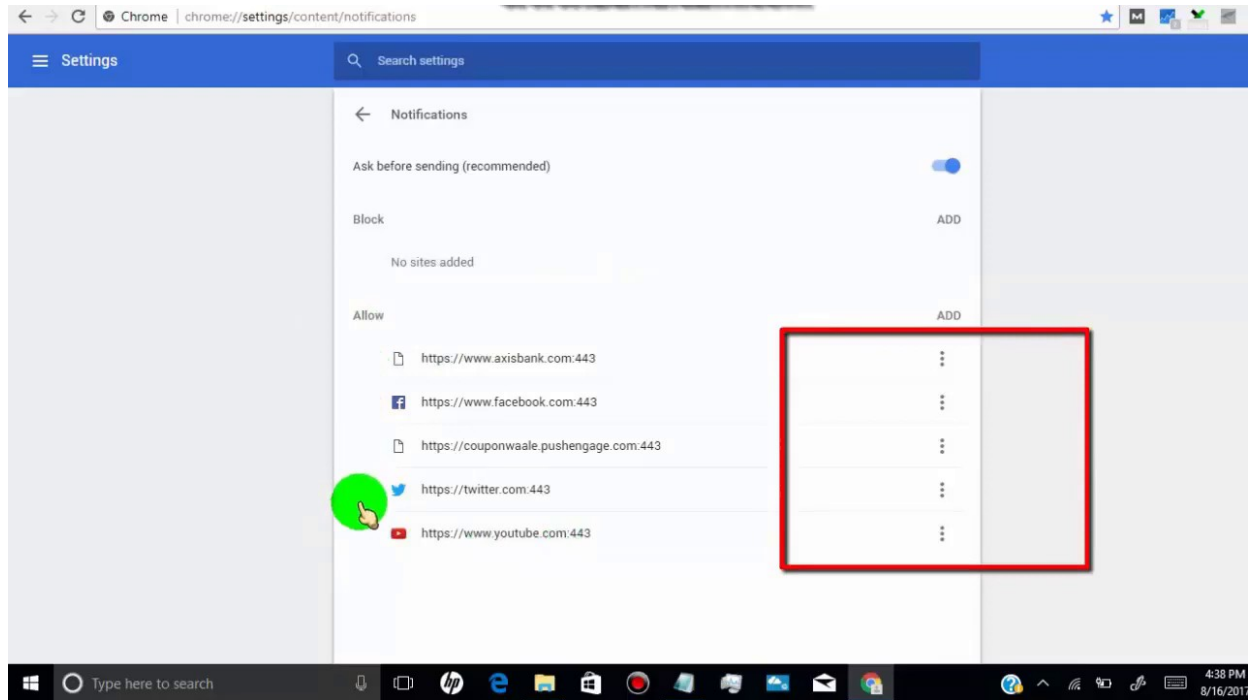
Under Permissions, select Notifications.

## STEP 4 Find the unwanted site

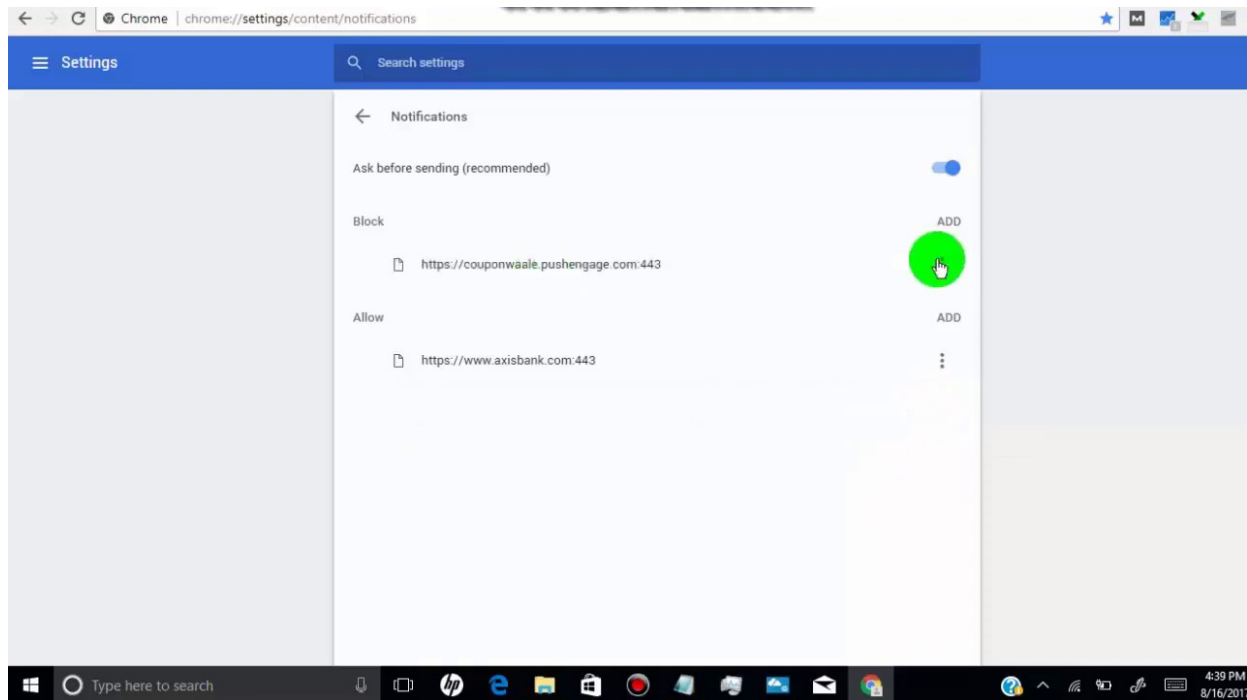
In the sites allowed to send notifications, find the website you want to stop.

## STEP 5 Block or remove the site

Open the site's menu and choose Block or Remove. Repeat for any other unwanted notification sources.
