

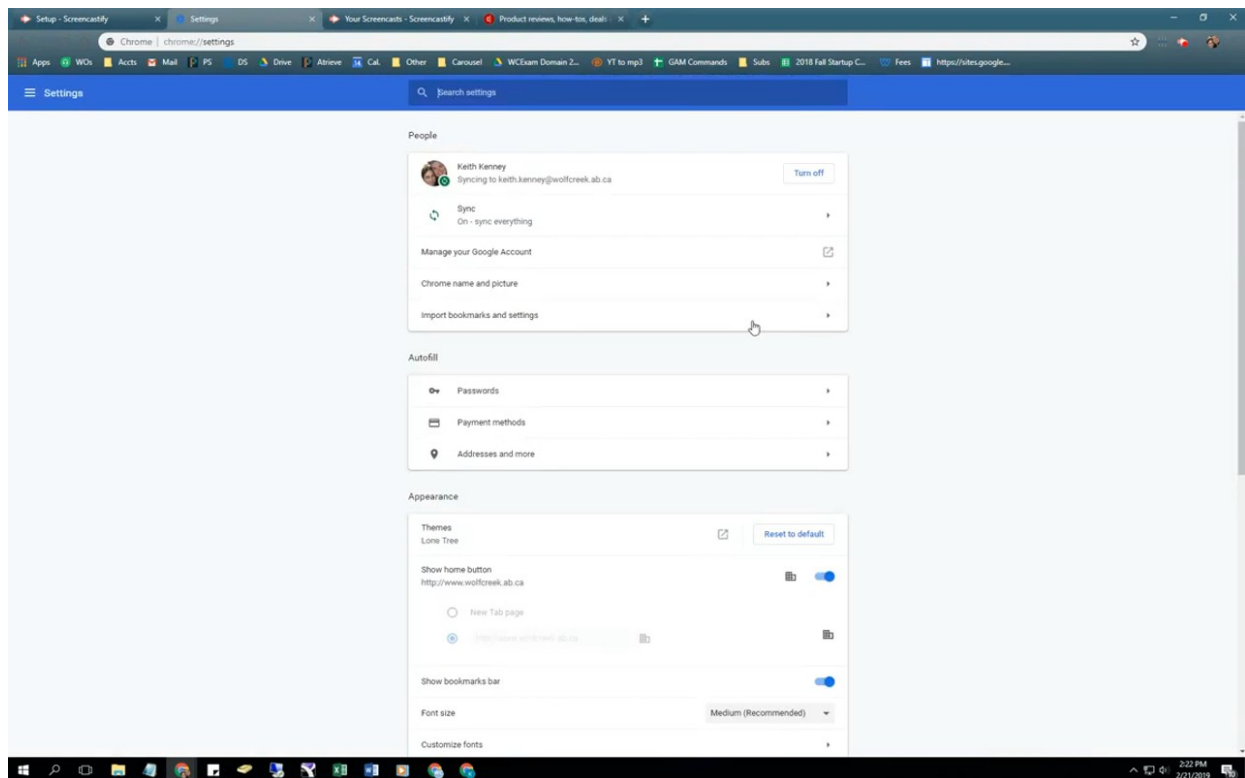
Remove Unwanted Chrome Pop-Ups

Google Chrome step-by-step guide

Before you begin: Chrome menus can move after an update. If a label looks different, use the search box at the top of Chrome Settings to find the named setting.

STEP 1 Open Chrome settings

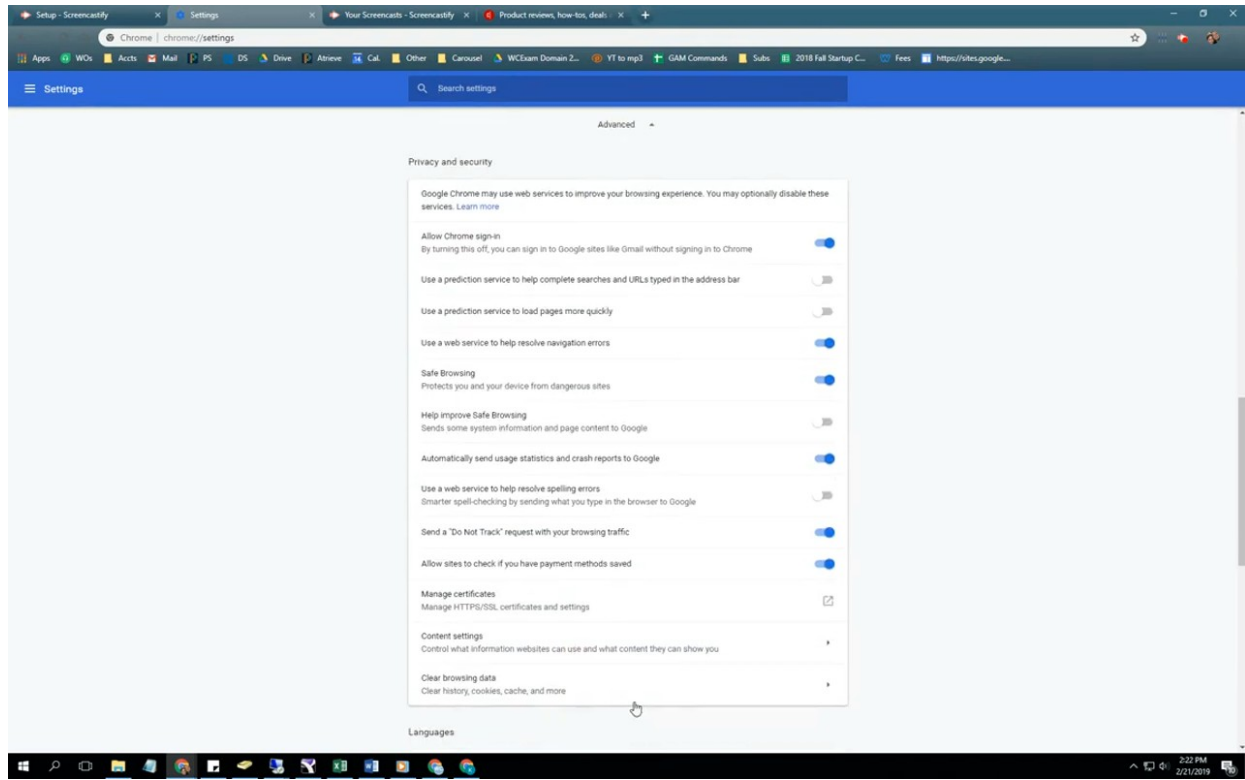
Open the three-dot Chrome menu and select Settings.

STEP 2 Open Privacy and security

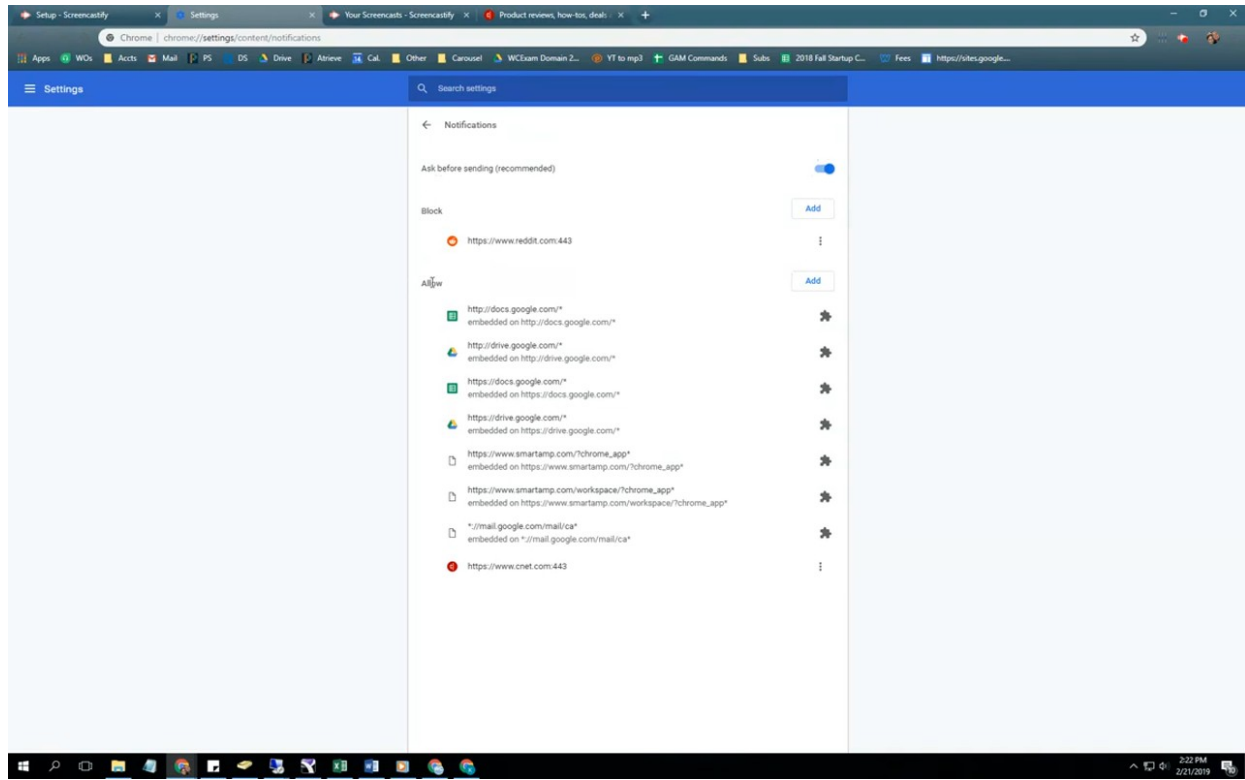
Select Privacy and security, then open Site settings.

STEP 3 Open Pop-ups and redirects

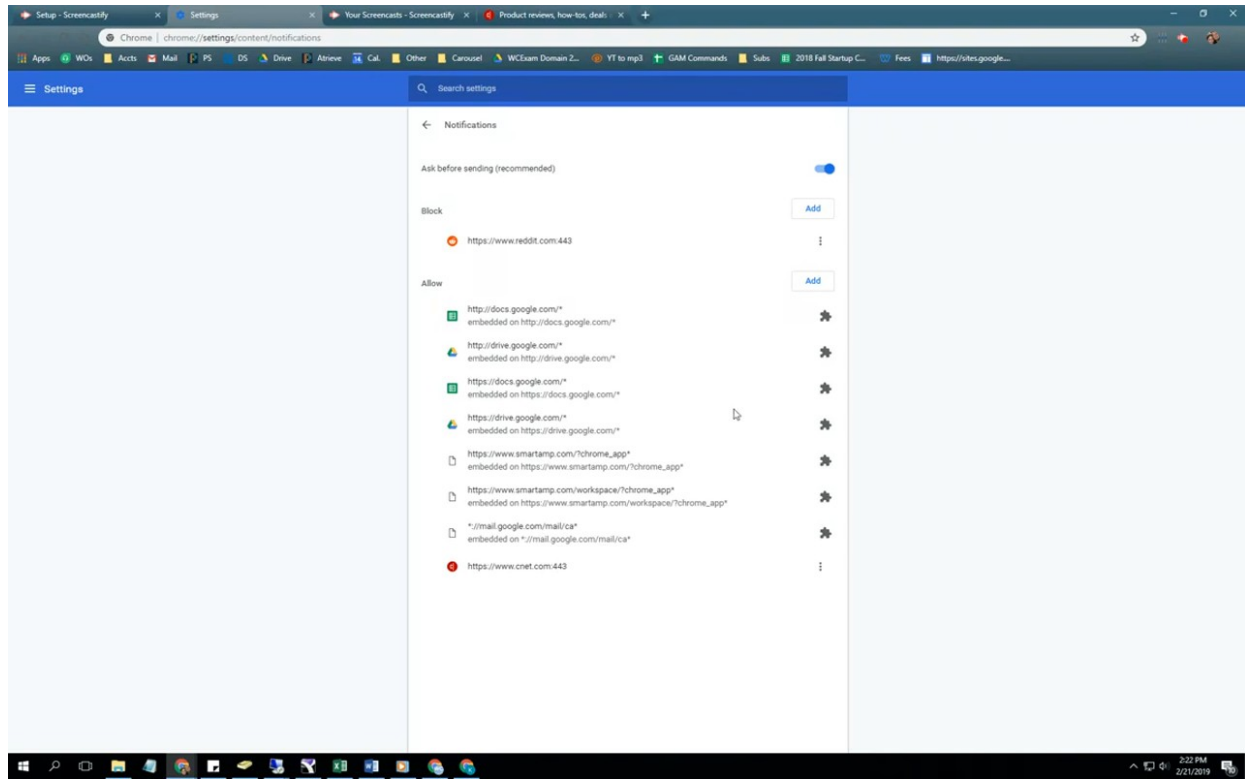
Under Content, select Pop-ups and redirects.

STEP 4 Block unwanted pop-ups

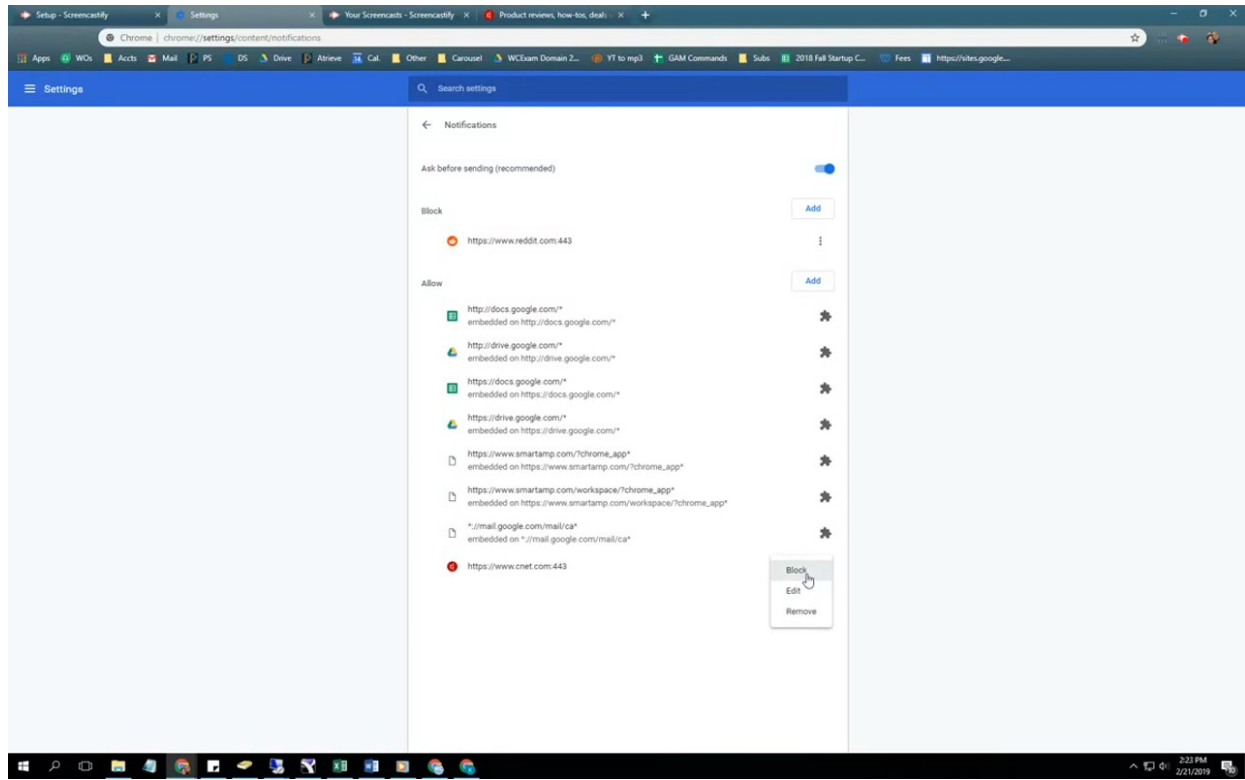
Set the default behaviour so sites cannot send pop-ups or use redirects.

STEP 5 Remove unwanted exceptions

Review the allowed-sites list and remove any site you do not recognize or no longer trust.
