

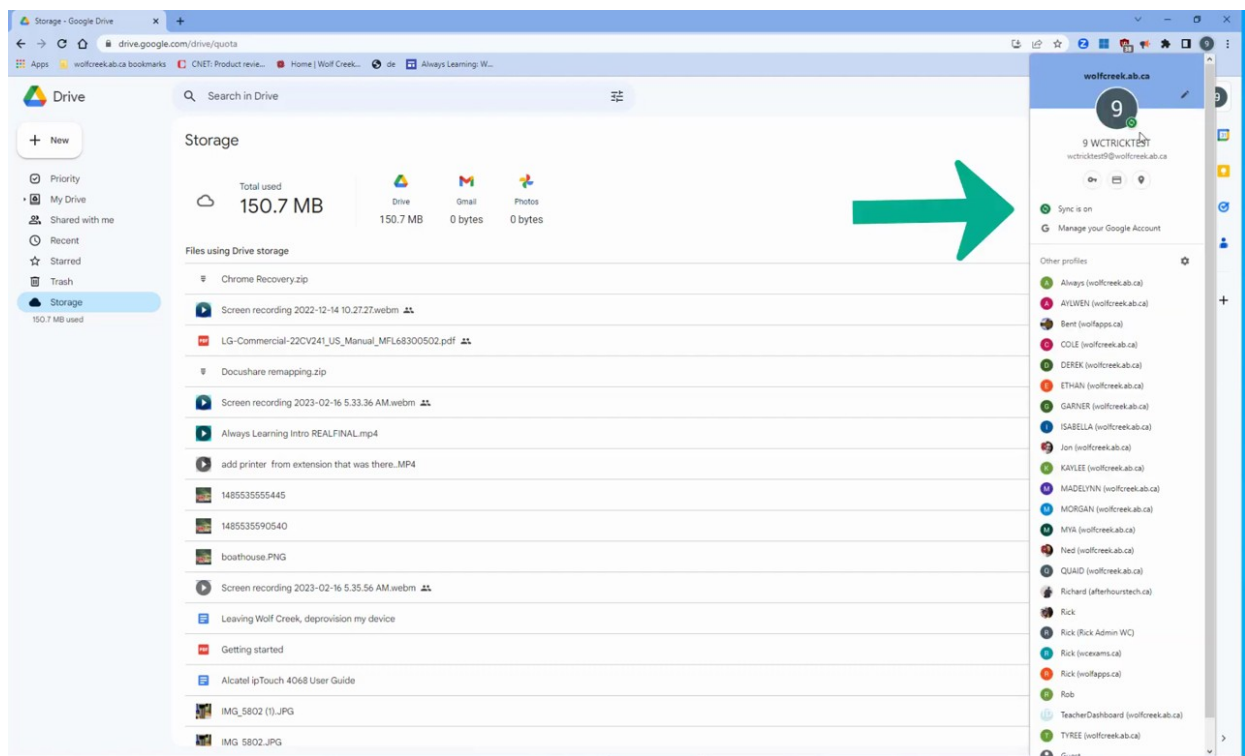

STEP 1 Open Chrome settings

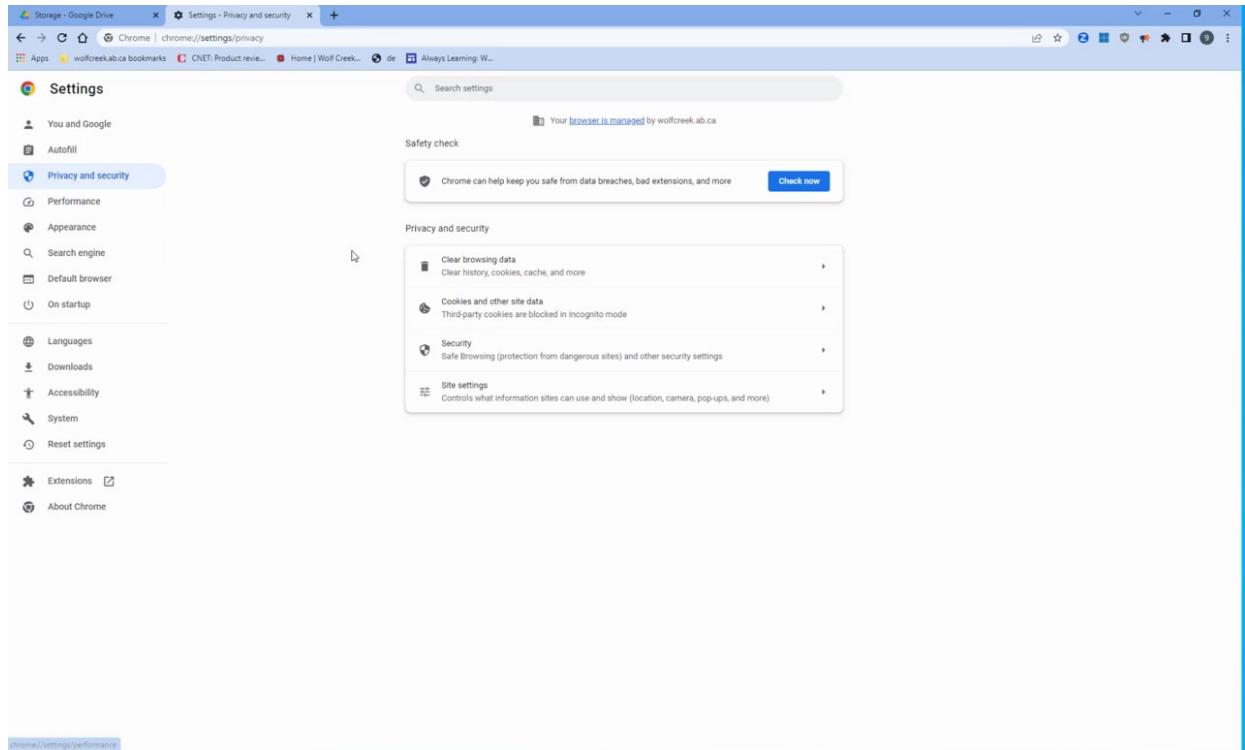
Select your Chrome profile, then open Settings.

STEP 2 Open Privacy and security

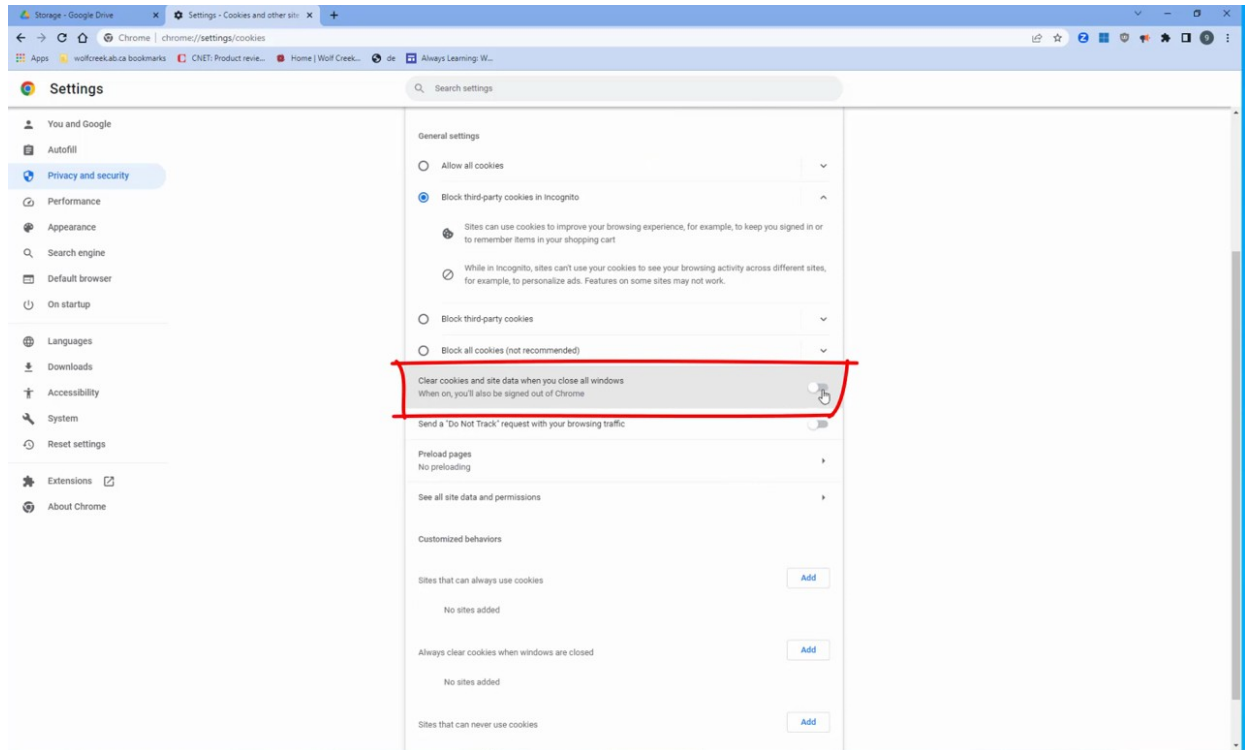
In Chrome Settings, select Privacy and security.

STEP 3 Open Cookies and other site data

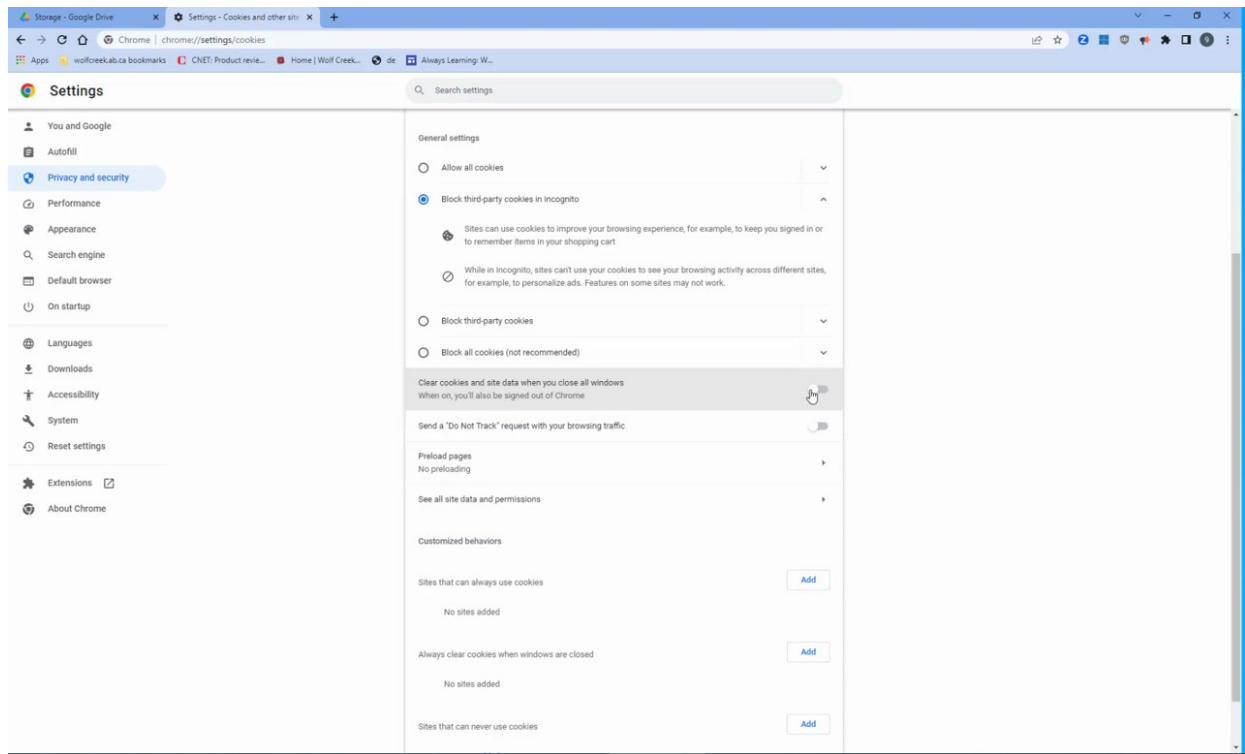
Select Cookies and other site data.

Turn off Clear cookies and site data when you close all windows. When this setting is on, Google may ask you to verify your account again after Chrome closes.
