

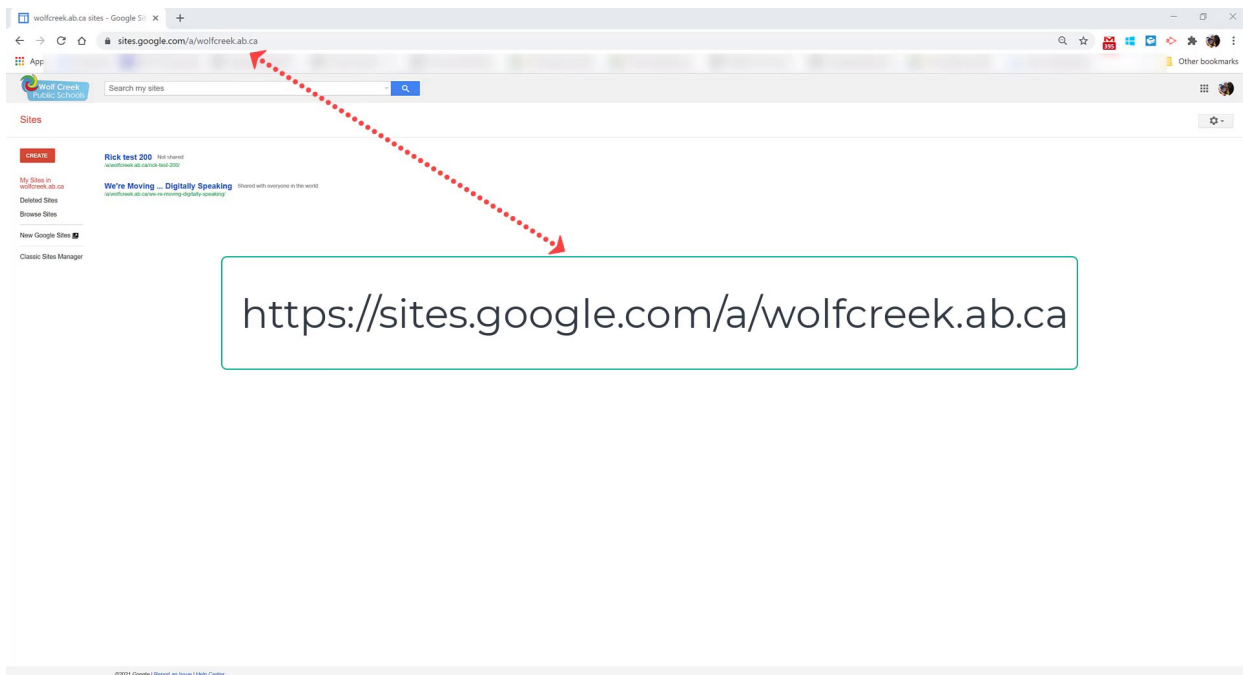
Convert a Classic Google Site to New Google Sites

Review an eligible Classic Google Site conversion and publish the resulting draft in New Google Sites.

Before you begin: Classic Sites has been retired. This guide is retained for old conversions that may still exist in an account; current sites should be created directly in New Google Sites.

STEP 1 Open the Classic Sites manager

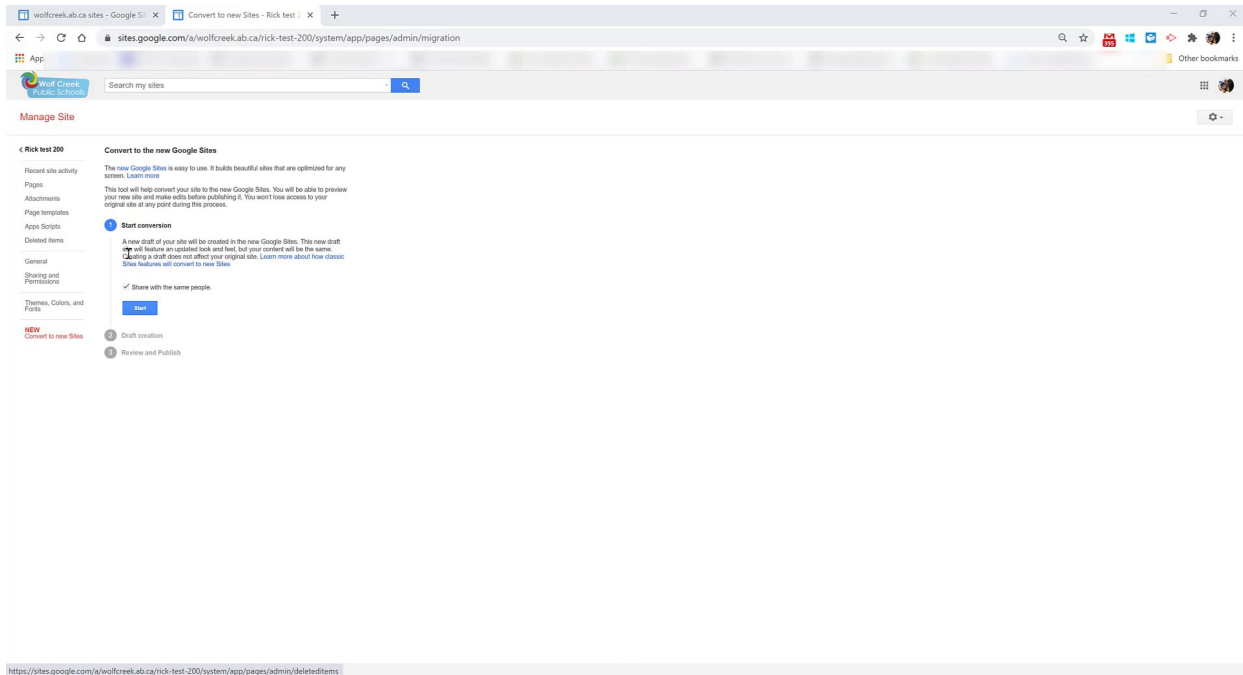
Open the Classic Sites address shown in the guide and sign in with the account that owns the original site.

STEP 2 Open the conversion controls

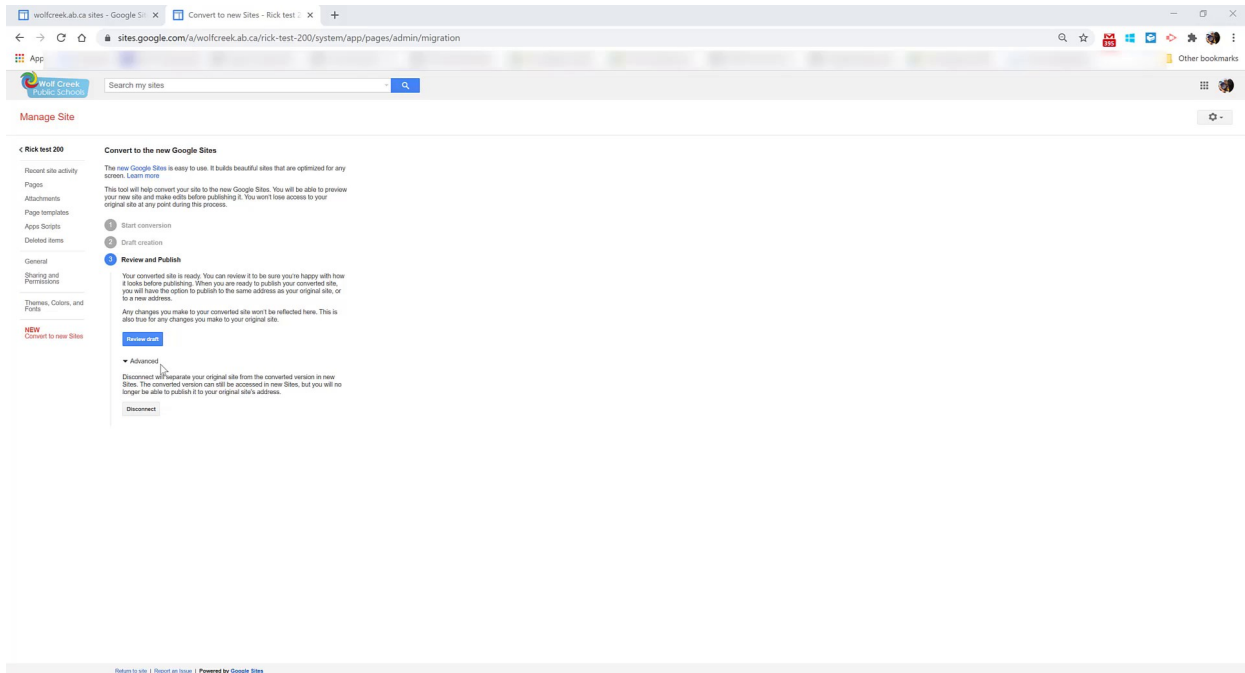
Select the site and use the conversion or management option to create or locate its New Google Sites draft.

STEP 3 Review the conversion

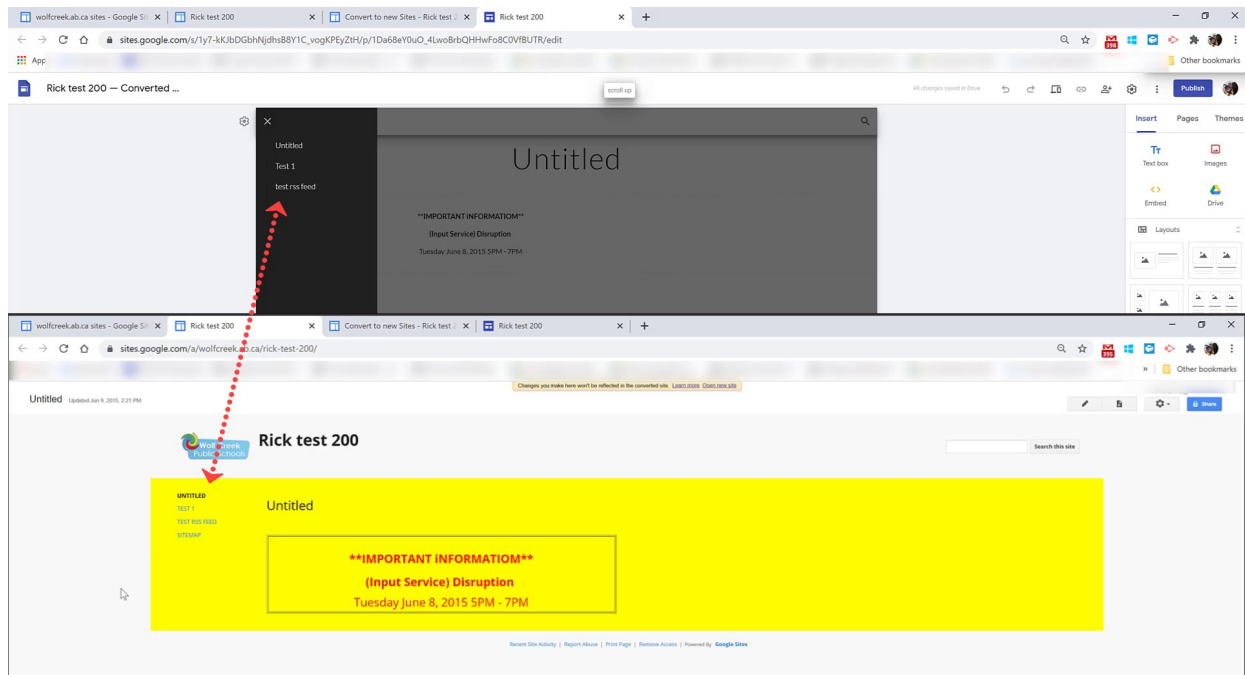
Read the conversion status and warnings. Open the converted draft and check every page, link, image, sharing setting, and embedded item.

STEP 4 Compare the old and new sites

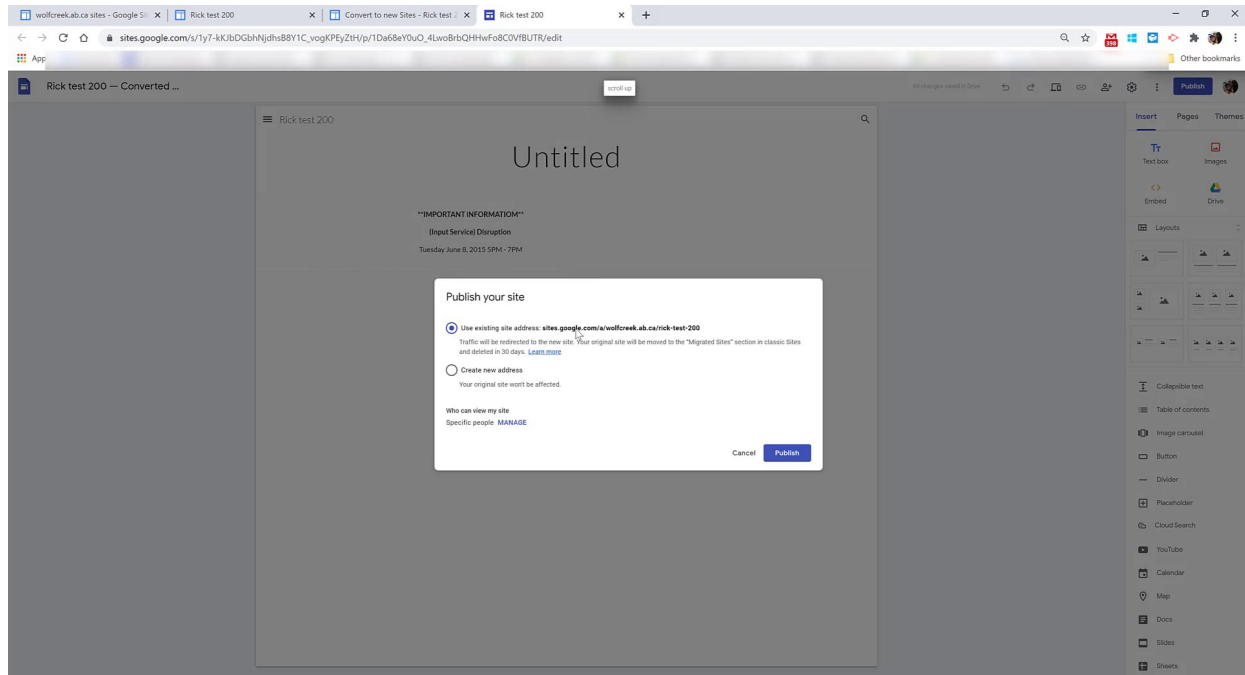
Keep the old content available while reviewing the new draft. Correct layout or content that did not transfer as expected.

STEP 5 Publish the new site

Select Publish, choose the web address and viewer permissions, then publish. Test the published address while signed out or in a private window.
