

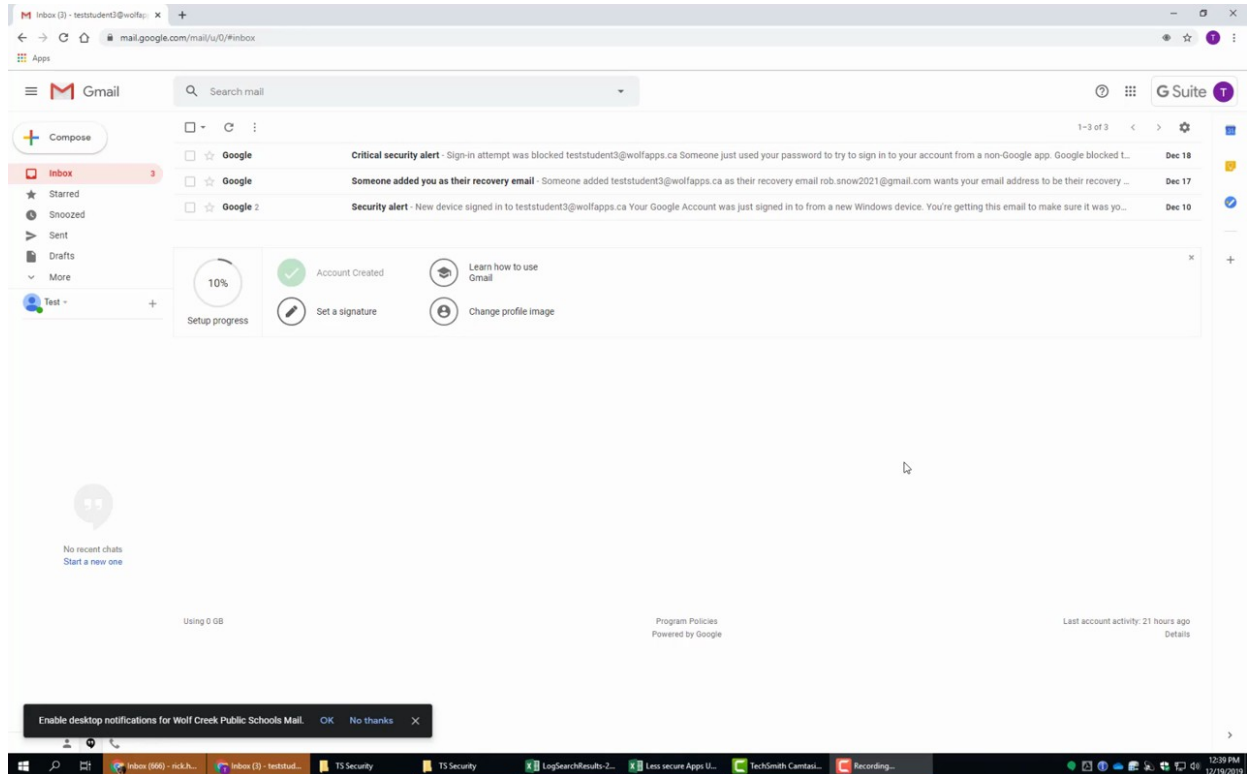
Google Emailed Security Alerts

Wolf Creek security guide

Security reminder: Stop when a request feels unusual or urgent. Verify it using a trusted method and contact Technology Services if you are unsure.

STEP 1 Read the alert carefully

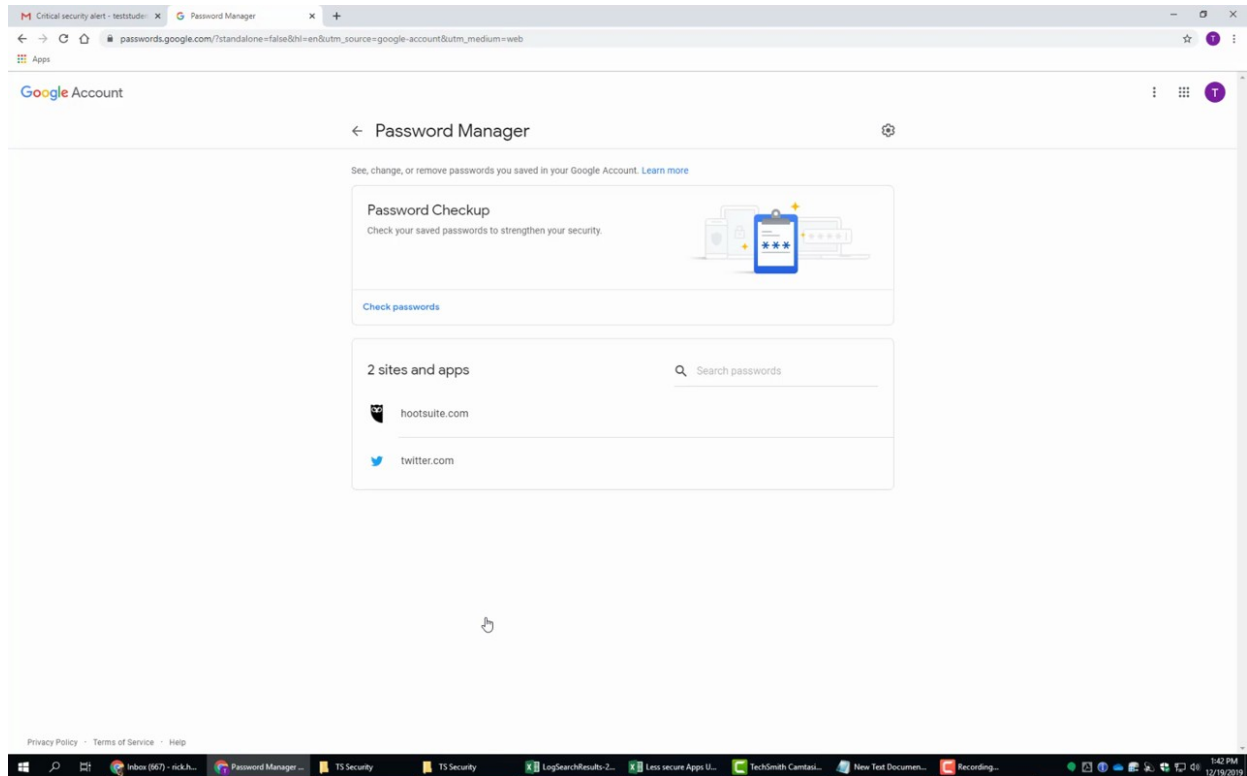
Check which account, device, location, and activity the Google security alert identifies.

STEP 2 Decide whether it was you

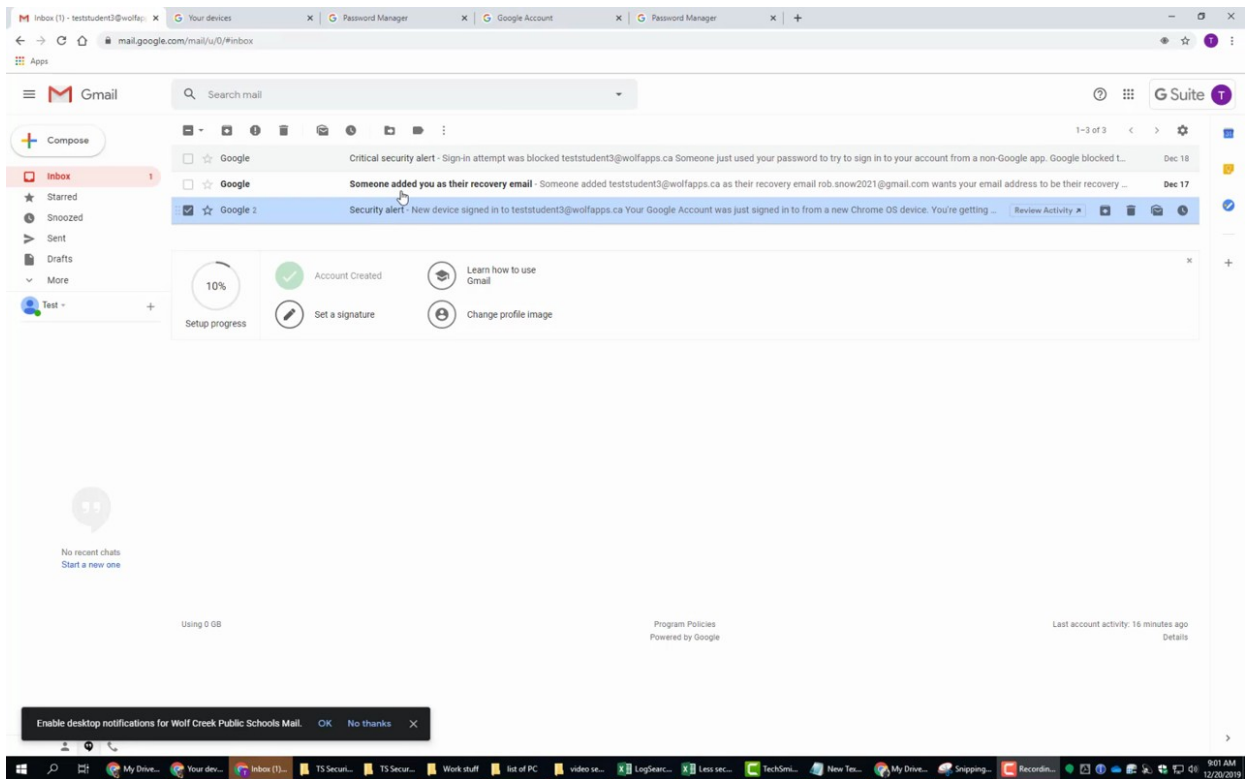
Compare the alert with your recent sign-ins or account changes.

STEP 3 Secure an unfamiliar event

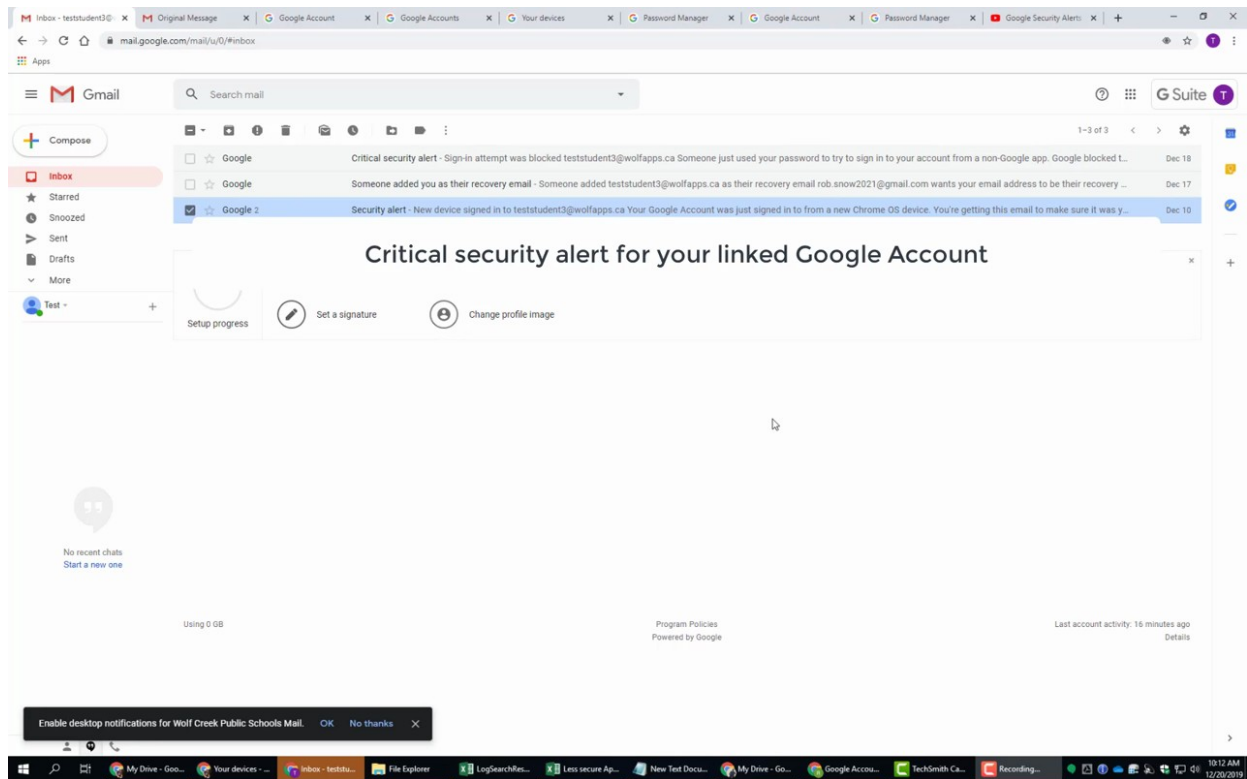
If you do not recognize the activity, follow Google's prompts to secure the account and change the password.

STEP 4 Review account security

Check recent security activity, signed-in devices, and two-step verification methods for anything else unfamiliar.
