

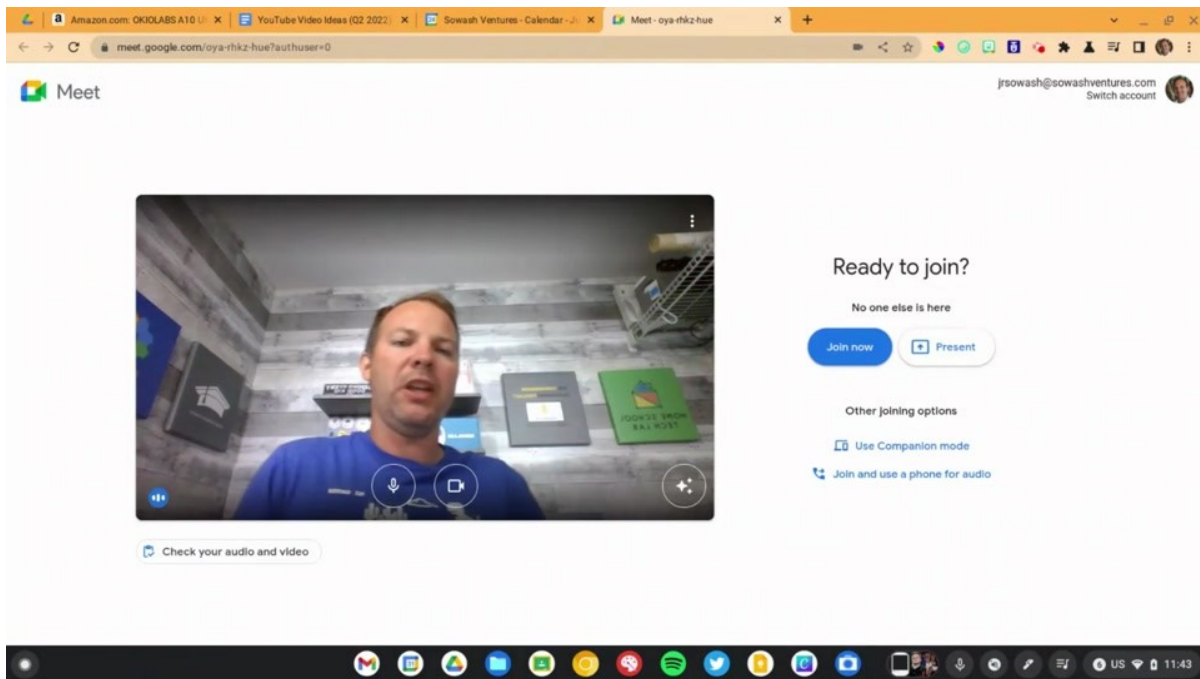
Use Companion Mode in Google Meet

Join a meeting from a second device without causing audio feedback.

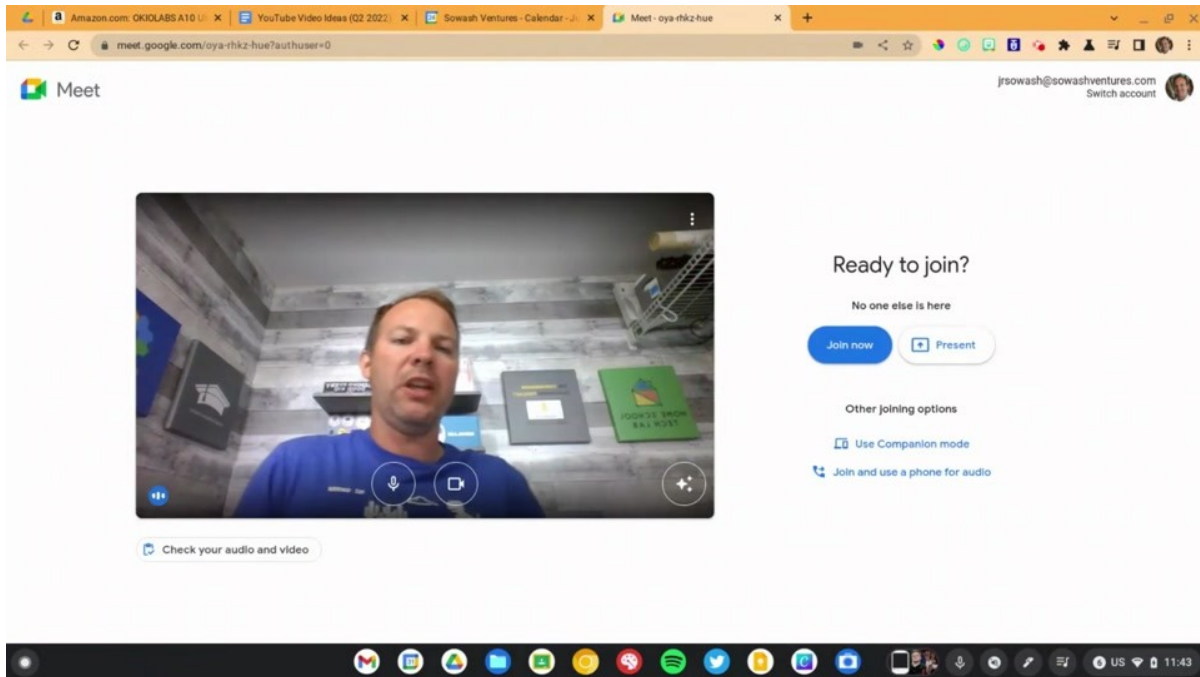
1. Open the Google Meet

Open the meeting link. If you are in a meeting room using shared audio and video equipment, do not select Join now on your second device.



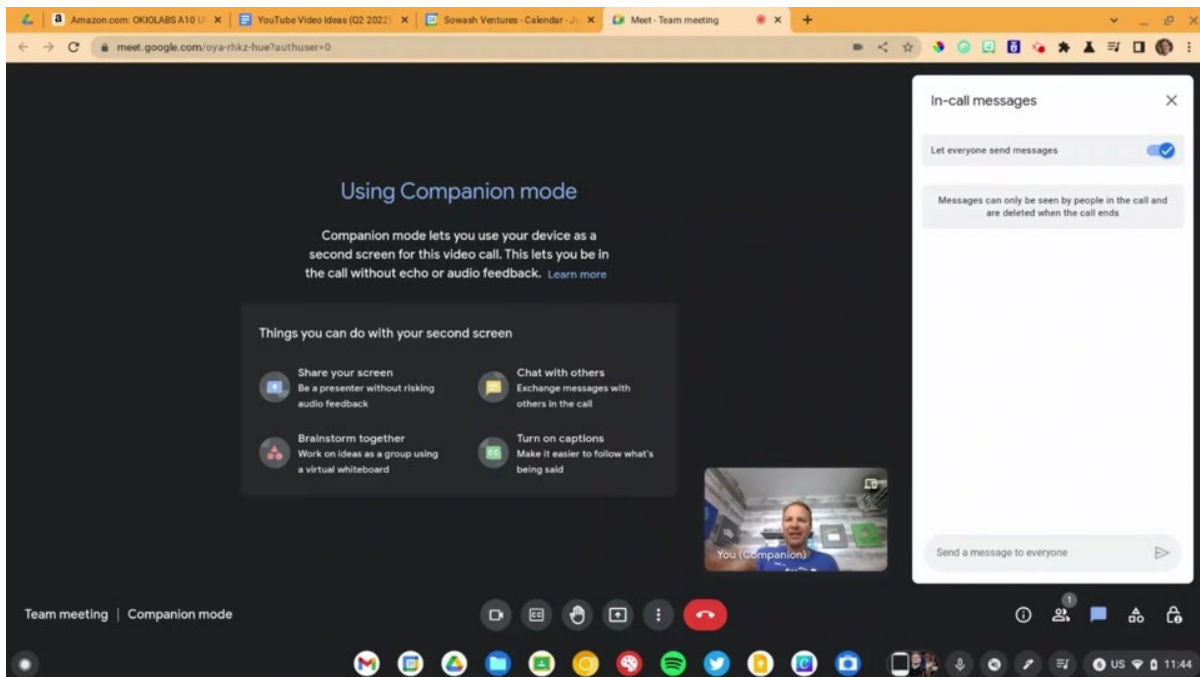
2. Choose Companion mode

On the meeting preview screen, select Use Companion mode. This joins without using the second device's microphone, speaker, or camera.



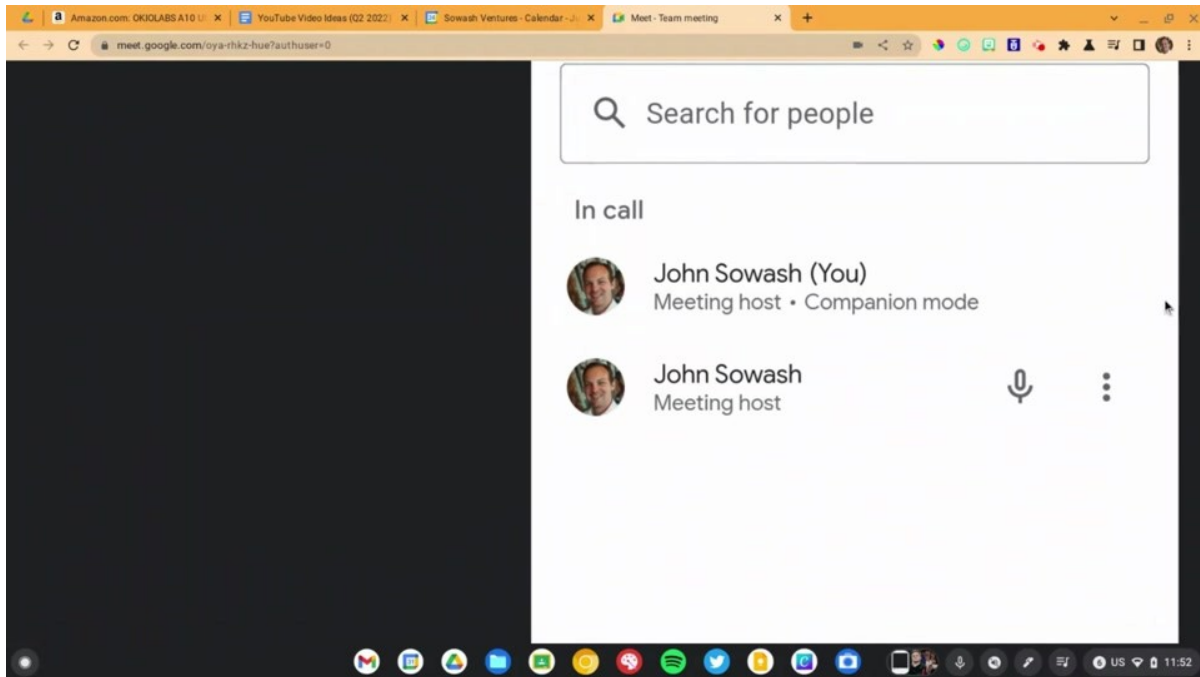
3. Use the companion controls

Use the second device to view chat, raise your hand, turn on captions, participate in polls, or share your screen while the room system handles audio and video.



4. Confirm both connections

The People panel may show both the meeting-room connection and the companion connection. This is expected.



5. Leave Companion mode

When the meeting is finished, select Leave call on the companion device. End the room connection separately if you are responsible for the meeting room.
