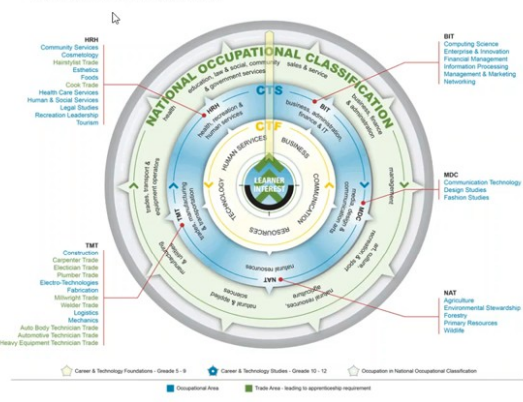

From the myBlueprint dashboard, open the Career Clusters activity.

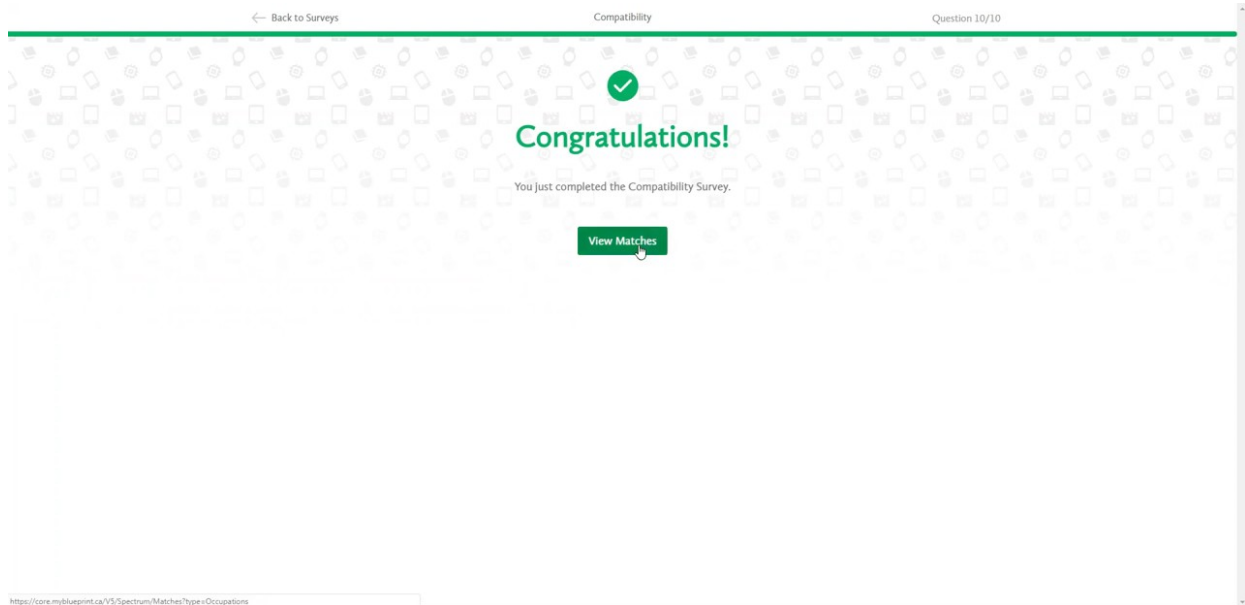
