

Setup up Google with a 2FA Security Key

Security reminder: Stop when a request feels unusual or urgent. Verify it using a trusted method and contact Technology Services if you are unsure.

STEP 1 Open two-step verification

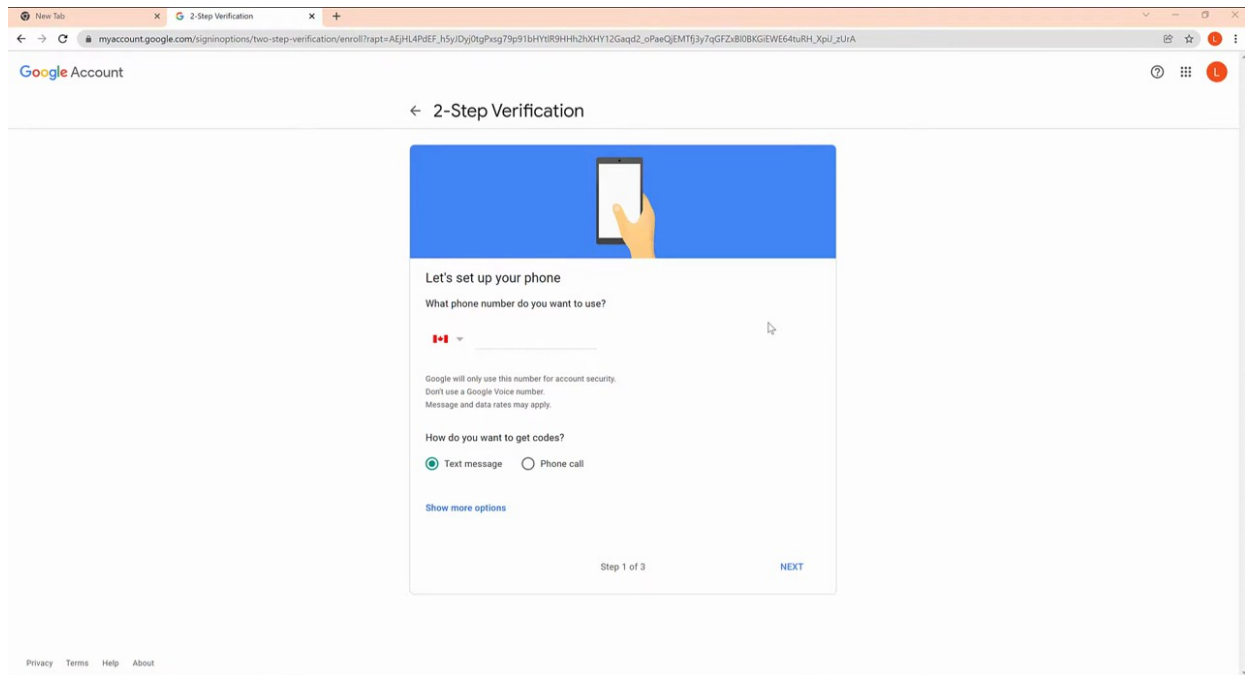
Open your Google Account security settings and select 2-Step Verification.

STEP 2 Add a security key

Choose Security key, then connect or activate the key when prompted.

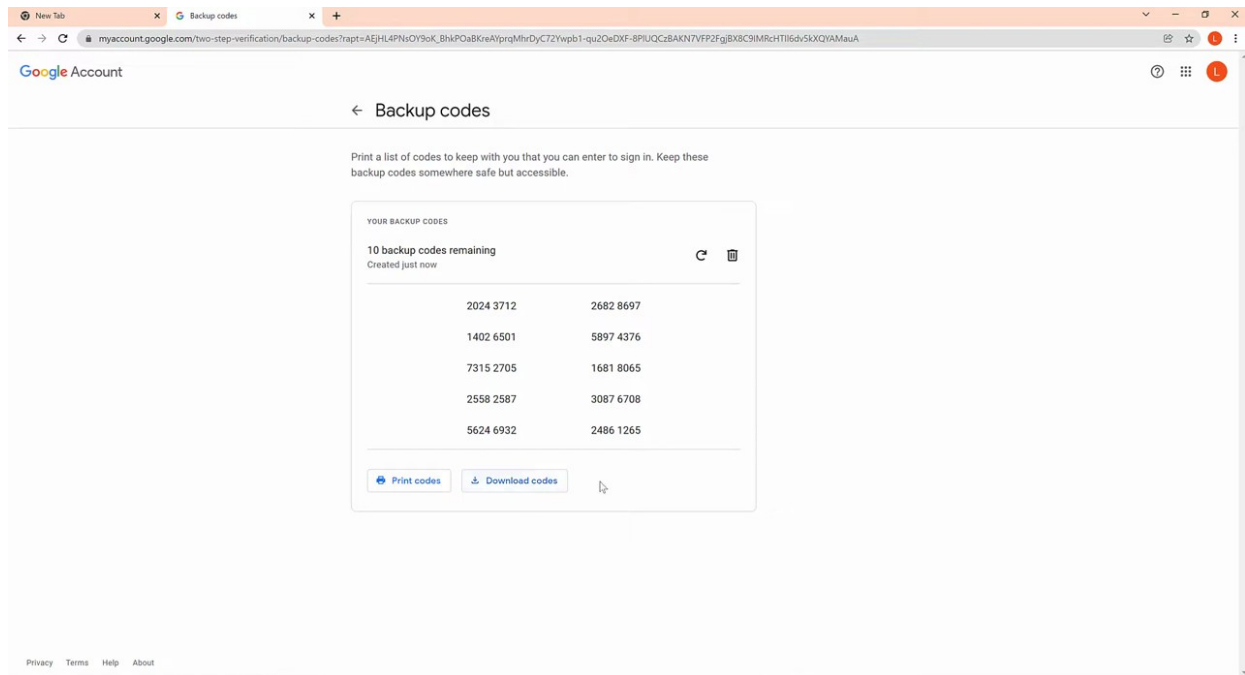

STEP 3 Register the key

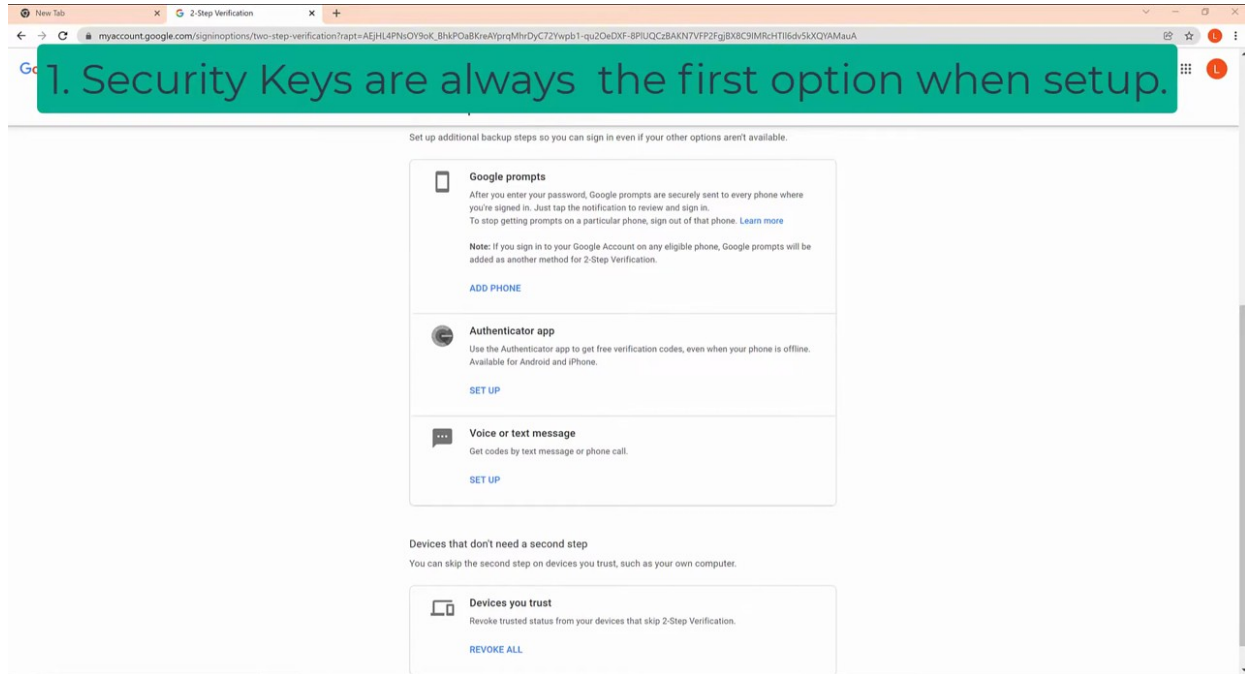
Touch or confirm the security key and give it a recognizable name.
