

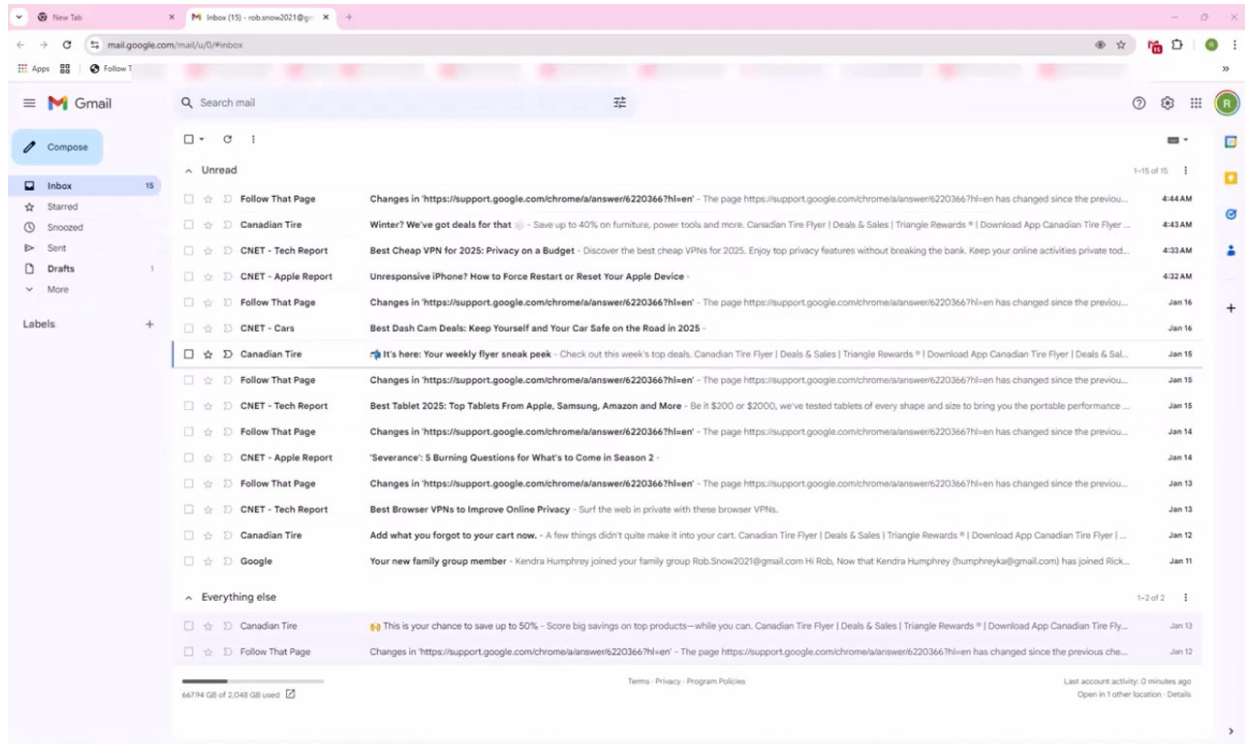

Wolf Creek security guide

Security reminder: Stop when a request feels unusual or urgent. Verify it using a trusted method and contact Technology Services if you are unsure.

STEP 1 Decide whether the sender is trusted

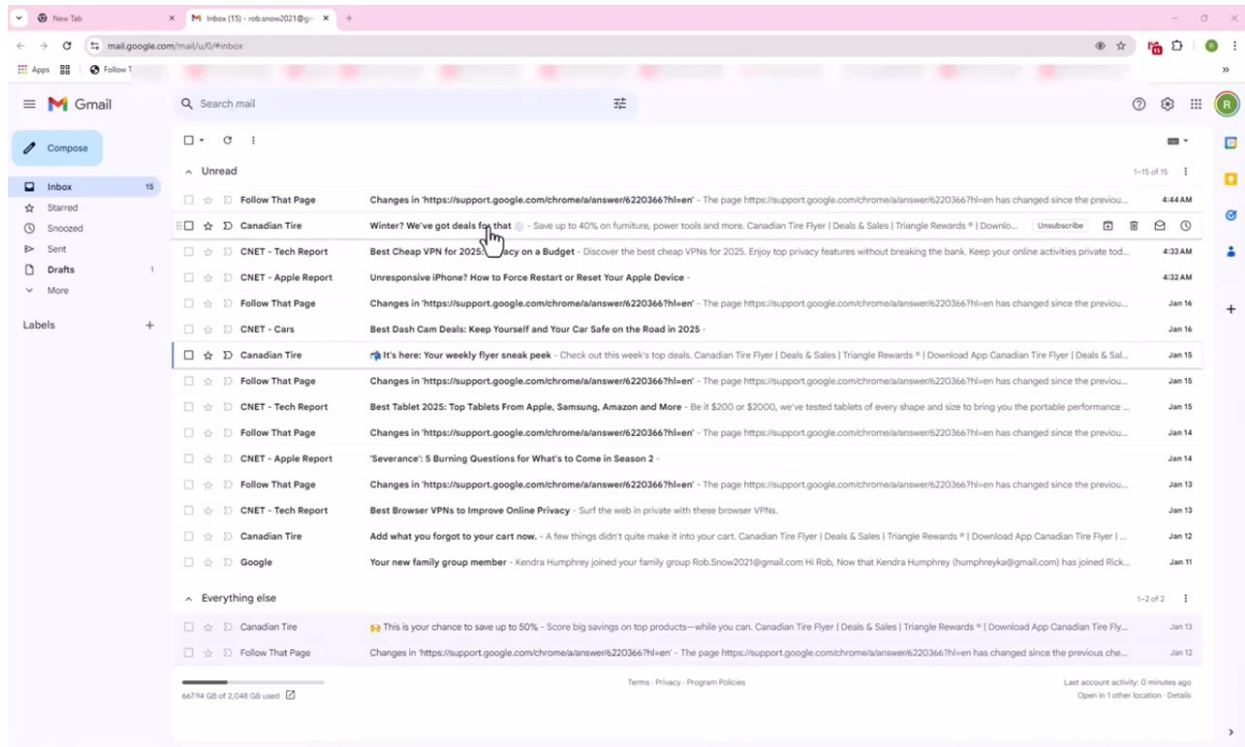
Use Unsubscribe only for legitimate mailing lists you recognize.

STEP 2 Use Gmail's unsubscribe control

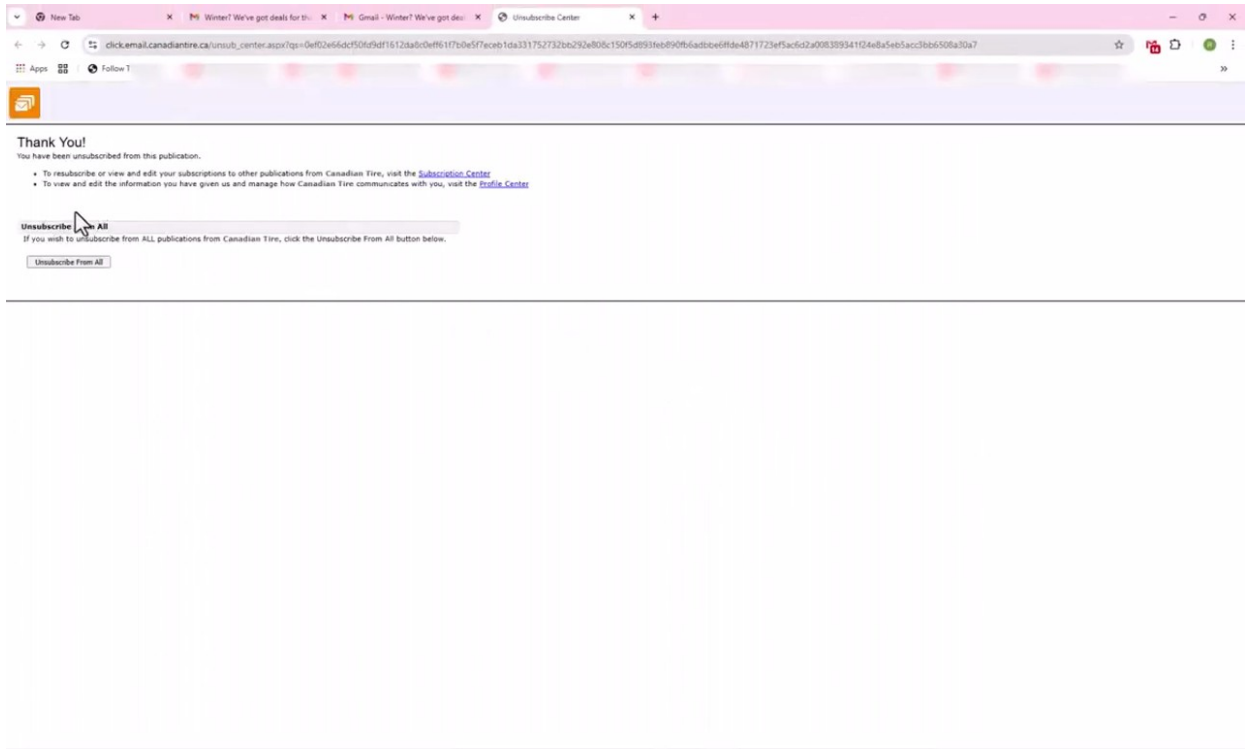
When available, select Unsubscribe beside the sender information at the top of the message.

STEP 3 Avoid links in suspicious email

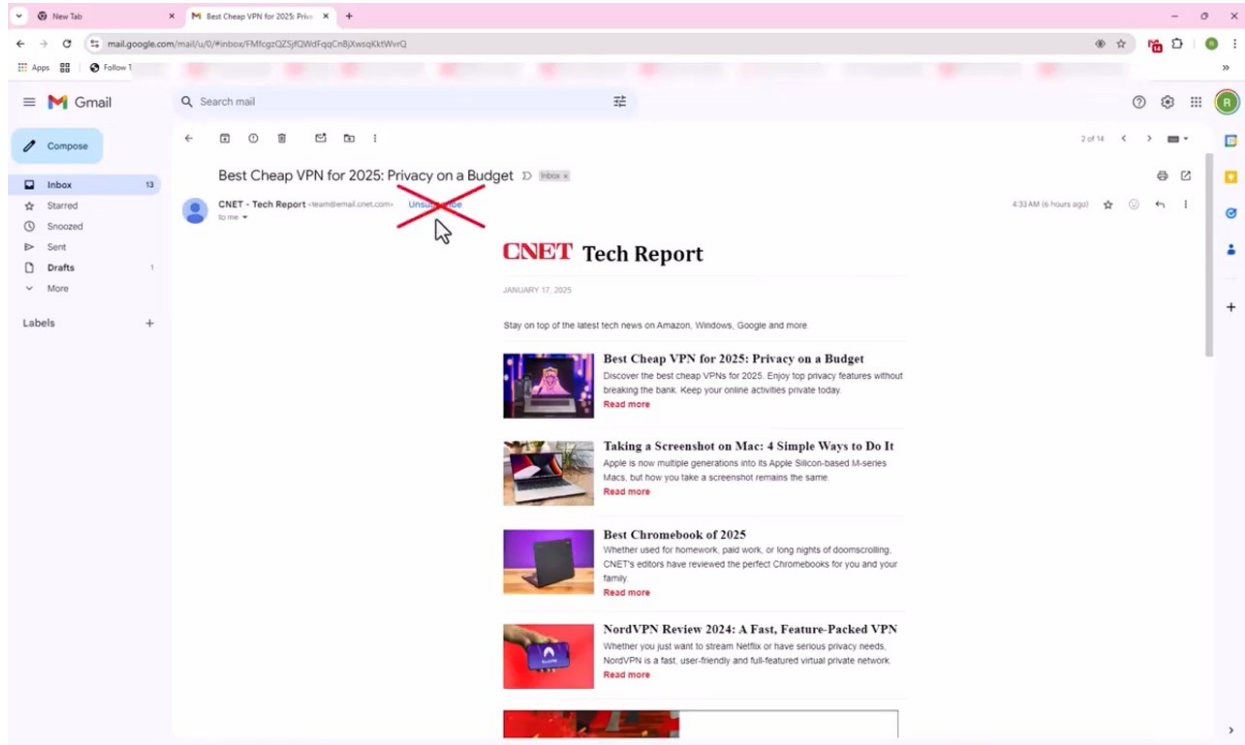
For unknown or suspicious senders, do not click an unsubscribe link because it may confirm your address or open a harmful site.

STEP 4 Report unwanted mail

Use Report spam or Report phishing for suspicious messages, then delete them.
