

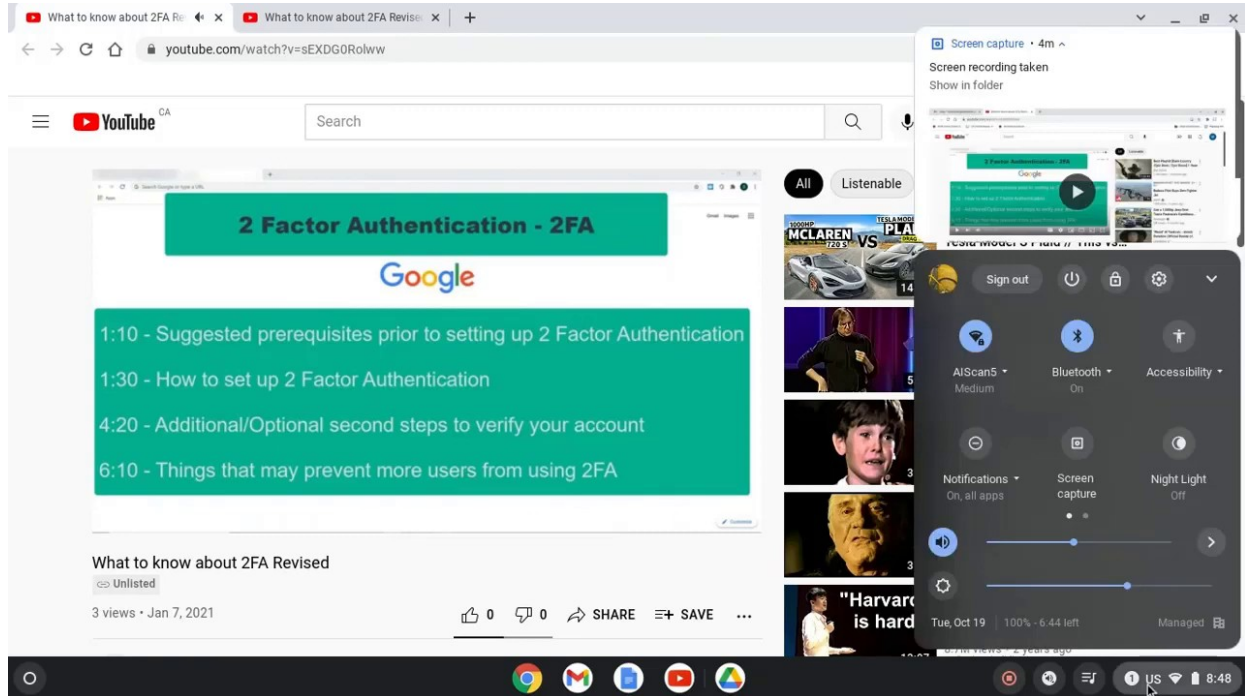
Use Live Caption on a Chromebook

Turn on automatic captions for supported audio and video playing in Chrome on a Chromebook.

Before you begin: Live Caption is generated on the device and may contain errors. Confirm names, technical terms, and important instructions rather than relying on captions alone.

STEP 1 Open Chromebook settings

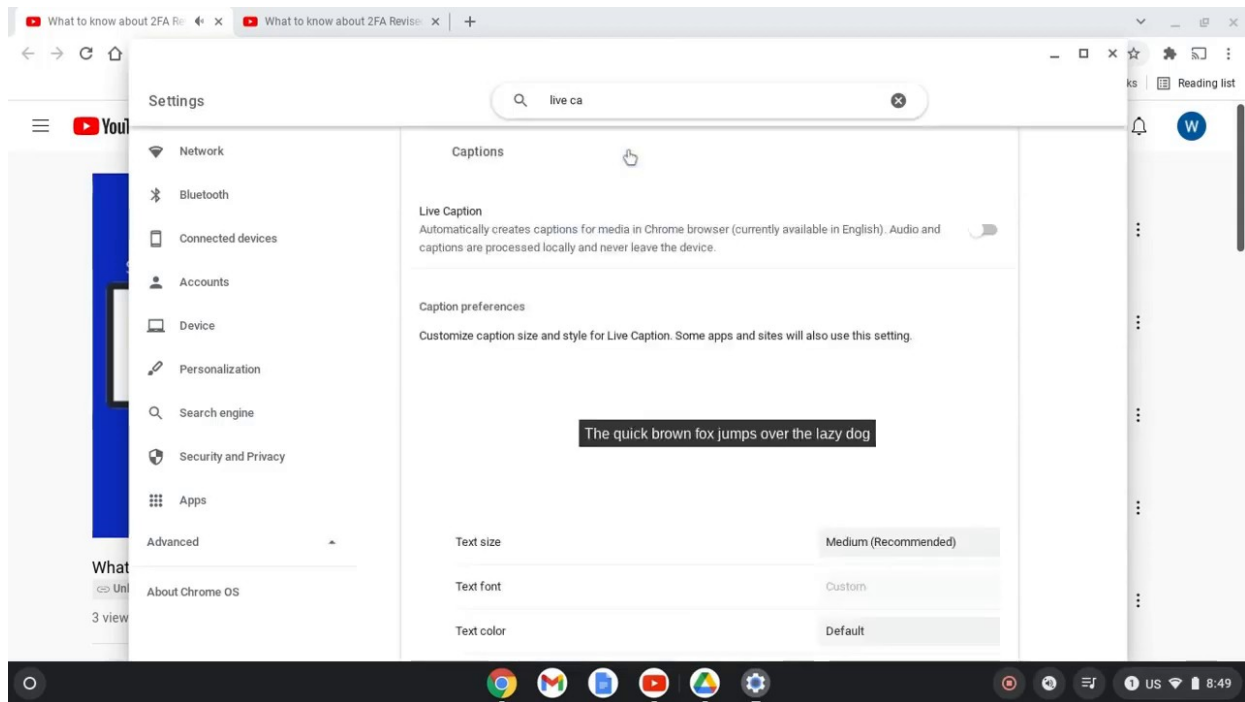
Select the status area at the bottom-right of the shelf, then select the Settings gear.

STEP 2 Find caption settings

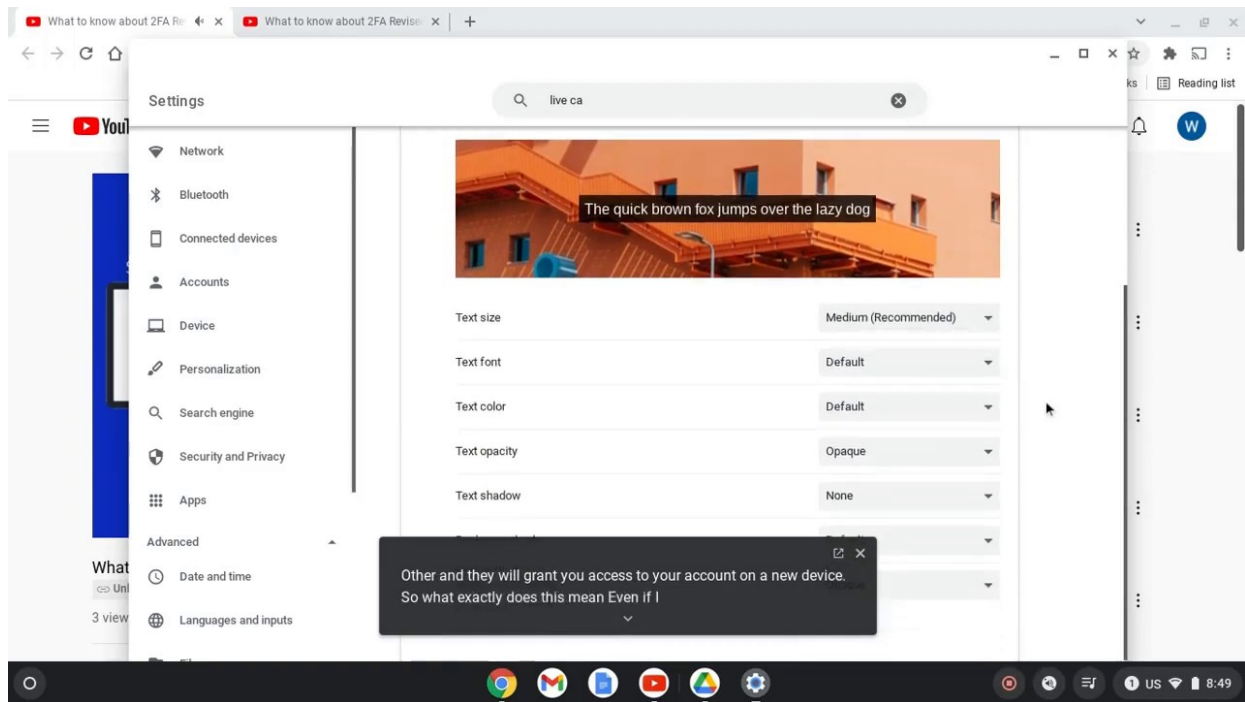
In Settings, search for live caption or open Advanced > Accessibility > Manage accessibility features.



Find caption settings.

STEP 3 Turn on Live Caption

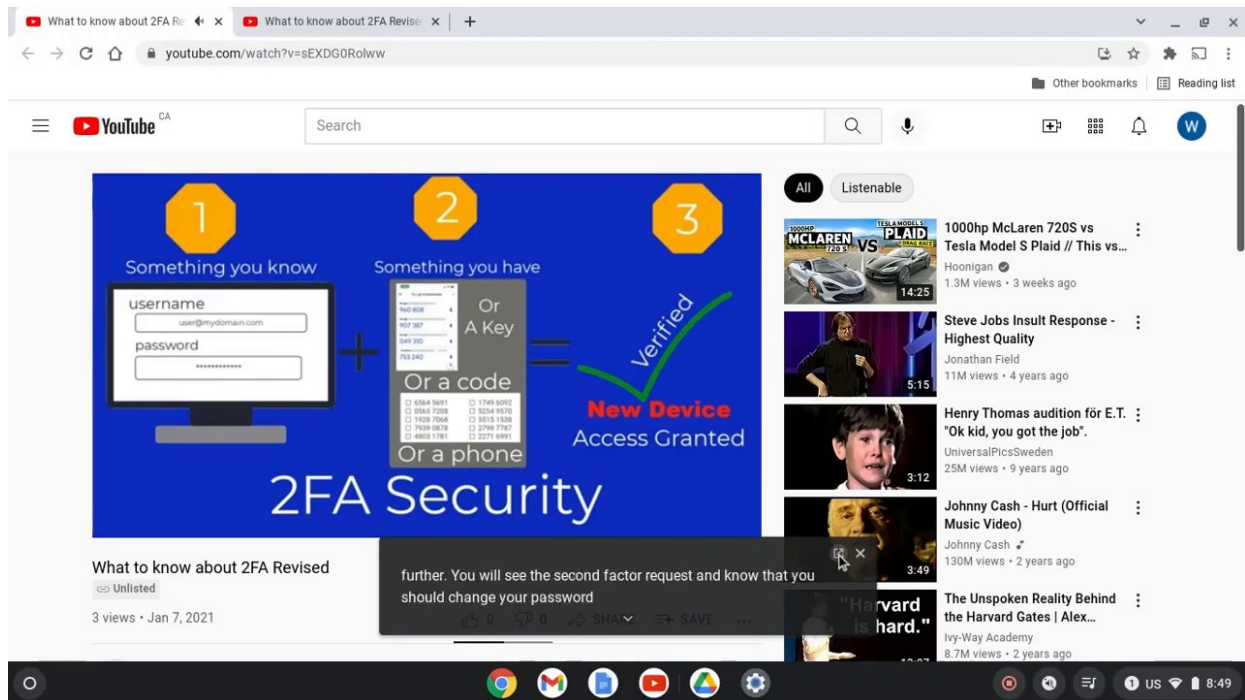
Under Captions, turn on Live Caption. Chrome may download the speech-recognition files the first time it is enabled.

STEP 4 Test and adjust captions

Play audio or video in Chrome and confirm the caption box appears. Adjust caption size and appearance in Settings if needed.
